I am responding to your request of March 10, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Record of the following:

- 1. Confirmation of 5G tower technology being installed in or near Stanley Park and English Bay area;
- 2. 5G strategy or plans for installation in Stanley Park, if available;
- 3. Name and contact information of experts, companies, or agencies involved in setting up the 5G technology; and
- 4. Confirmation of public involvement in strategic plans. Date range: January 1, 2019 to March 10, 2024.

All responsive records are attached.\* Some information in the records has been severed (blacked out) under s.13(1), 15(1)(I), s.17(1), and s.22(3)(d) of the Act. You can read or download these sections here:

\*Please note, the records reflect potential installation of 5G infrastructure that did not occur; however, no 5G tower technology was installed in Stanley Park, and there are no records in relation to points one, three, or four.

Apologies for not following up with you on this since my last email from January. Below are some of the concerns I had with the proposal and right-of-entry agreement:

- The email chain or the agreement does not include any discussion of how the service will be installed (aerial drops, conduits, etc.) and if any ground disturbance/construction is required.
- The steps outlined by Sean (Telus) seems to indicate that they need the right-of-entry agreement to be signed prior to starting the site review and design process. He also indicates that there will be an approval process once the design is complete.

- The agreement requires the City to provide Telus with notice on any hazardous materials.
  - While we always endeavour to provide any information we have, the responsibility and liability for this should rest solely on Telus.

The agreement is also missing standard terms that we always include for insurance, hours of work, builder's liens, restoration and covenants, release and indemnity. We can execute a separate agreement for the construction to cover these, but I think it is best if we are up front with our requirements.

- 1. The attached Right of Entry (ROE) agreement is completed and signed by the authorized signatories.
- 2. The ROE agreement is processed, and this triggers a design walkthrough to be scheduled at the property to determine the installation method.
- 3. The installation method proposal is sent to the signing authorities for approval. We require the approval of the installation method to move forward with the upgrade.
- 4. Our installation team schedules an installation start date to bring fibre to each building.
- 5. TELUS PureFibre services become available to all businesses that operate in the park and they can sign up for services if interested.

Did you receive any of the attachments from the earlier emails in the chain? There was apparently a Right of Entry (ROE) agreement that identified the buildings/locations where the service might be installed.

The email chain doesn't include any discussion of how the service will be installed (aerial drops, conduits, etc.) and what would be involved. Looking at the steps provided by Sean in the first email, I'm concerned that Telus/Ledcor may have not looked at the logistics yet since they seem to require the ROE to be signed first before initiating the design.

I'm also not sure if they understand the archaeological constraints in Stanley Park. BC Hydro understands the archaeology and First Nations engagement process very well, but even they had a very difficult time coordinating their permits for their upgrades last year.
