Re: **Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")**

I am responding to your request of March 14, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Record of "agreement between the Province and Concord Pacific Holdings Ltd. which provides that Concord will make payments to the Province once the density on certain Concord lands reaches prescribed levels" as mentioned on page 36 of the "Removal of the Georgia and Dunsmuir Viaducts" report from the October 20, 2015 Council Meeting (<https://council.vancouver.ca/20151020/documents/rr1.pdf>). Date range: January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located. The Director of Real Estate has advised our office that the City does not have a copy of the agreement, which will be registered on title.
