The Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation regrets to announce that the Stanley Park Easter Train will not operate on Saturday, March 30, following a minor incident on Friday evening causing damage to a section of track.

The incident occurred during routine closedown procedures, when the train was being transported for

overnight storage. No guests were on site and no staff were injured.

Saturday ticket holders will be automatically refunded through the ShowPass account used to purchase the ticket. Sunday and Monday ticket holders will also have the option to refund their tickets through ShowPass.

Preliminary assessments suggest that the damage is minor. With the safety of staff and guests as our top priority, the train will be closed to allow maintenance by contractors and a thorough safety inspection by Technical Safety BC.

Good Evening Commissioners,

I'm pleased to provide the following update related to the Stanley Park Train.

Repairs to the track performed this morning were completed successfully. We will be contacting all ticket holders for Sunday and Monday's event this evening to advise of this development. An official decision on reopening is dependent upon a final Technical Safety BC evaluation which is scheduled to commence at 7am Sunday morning. Staff are planning to make a definitive communication on the reopening by 8:30am Sunday morning via direct contact through the ticketing provider and via our social media channels.

Along with the repairs to the track, all train passenger carts in operation were assessed for defects. Unfortunately, the accessible carriage, which was involved in the incident on Friday has been removed from service as it requires further testing before it can be cleared to return to operation. This work will be prioritized upon the end of the Easter event's run. Staff have made contact with each of the families impacted and have made arrangements to make up for the disappointment caused through accommodations at a future event at the train.

I extend my utmost appreciation to the staff team, and contractors who made themselves available this morning and afternoon to assist in the effort to return the train to service.

I'm pleased to provide the following update related to the Stanley Park Train.

Repairs to the track performed this morning were completed successfully. We will be contacting all ticket holders for Sunday and Monday's event this evening to advise of this development. An official decision on reopening is dependent upon a final Technical Safety BC evaluation which is scheduled to commence at 7am Sunday morning. Staff are planning to make a definitive communication on the reopening by 8:30am Sunday morning via direct contact through the ticketing provider and via our social media channels.

Along with the repairs to the track, all train passenger carts in operation were assessed for defects. Unfortunately, the accessible carriage, which was involved in the incident on Friday has been removed from service as it requires further testing before it can be cleared to return to operation. This work will be prioritized upon the end of the Easter event's run. Staff have made contact with each of the families impacted and have made arrangements to make up for the disappointment caused through accommodations at a future event at the train.

I extend my utmost appreciation to the staff team, and contractors who made themselves available this morning and afternoon to assist in the effort to return the train to service.

The Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation regrets to announce that the Stanley Park Easter Train will not operate on Saturday, March 30, following a minor incident on Friday evening causing damage to a section of track.

The incident occurred during routine closedown procedures, when the train was being transported for overnight storage. No guests were on site and no staff were injured.

Saturday ticket holders will be automatically refunded through the ShowPass account used to purchase the ticket. Sunday and Monday ticket holders will also have the option to refund their tickets through ShowPass.

Preliminary assessments suggest that the damage is minor. With the safety of staff and guests as our top priority, the train will be closed to allow maintenance by contractors and a thorough safety inspection by Technical Safety BC.
