Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (The "Act")

I am responding to your request of August 16, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Blueprints, building plans, or photographs from 1933 to 1981 of the BC Children's Hospital (formerly known as the "Crippled Children's Hospital") that was located at West 59th Avenue.

The requested architectural plans and drawings are routinely available on a fee for service basis from the Development and Building Services Centre with the owners' written permission, and as a result, those records are not subject to the Act, as per s.3(5)(a).
