Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of December 11, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

In regards to any RFP issued regarding pretreatment information management software tool in the Water Division:

- 1. A list of vendors who reached out with their proposals;
- 2. Record of what the City of Vancouver was doing before utilizing this software; and
- 3. The metric/scorecard used to evaluate them.

Date range: September 1, 2024 to September 30, 2024.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located. Supply Chain Management staff have advised our office that the RFP has not been completed and is still an active procurement; therefore, the records for points one and three are not yet available.

In regard to point two, the Director of Water & Utilities Management has advised that the City currently uses a drive-by automatic meter reading (AMR) system for collecting consumption data. The AMR hardware and software are provided by Sensus. The AMR technology has been used to collect water meter data since 2006. Prior to 2006 water meters were read using manual means.
