Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of December 11, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Record of CCTV footage in the parking area of 299 W 68th Avenue relating to a hit and run incident on November 25, 2024 at 6:30am.

Due to the nature of the incident and the requested records, our office suggests you contact the Vancouver Police Department to open an investigation. You may contact their non-emergency line at 604-717-3321. Our office has confirmed that the footage has been held and can be made available to the VPD if an investigation were to be opened and the responsive footage requested in 30 business days (February 4, 2025).

Under Part 5 of the Act, you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your FOI request by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc.bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.

If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number (2024-719); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request; and 4) detailed reasons why you are seeking the review.
