Re: **Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")**

I am responding to your request of December 12, 2024 under the ***Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*** for:

Record of the installation of bike-related or bike lane-related temporary signage in Stanley Park (e.g. direction signs, traffic separation signs, safety signs, barriers etc.) that were installed next to or on roads in Stanley Park – limited to Stanley Park Drive between Pipeline Road and Prospect point, publicly accessible roads only. Specifically, the signs (if any) that were facing traffic prior to the full-scale deployment of signs and pylons that happened in May 2021. Date range: March 1, 2021 to April 30, 2021.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located.

Park Board staff have advised our office that during the requested time period of March 1, 2021 to April 30, 2021, Stanley Park Drive was similar to its current conditions with two lanes of vehicle traffic; the temporary bike lane #1 (part of the COVID-19 Pandemic Response) had been removed as of September 26, 2020.

Under section 52 of the Act, and within 30 business days of receipt of this letter, you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your FOI request by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc.bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.
