Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of December 13, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Record of the computer model file (in FBX format) that shows the 10 year, 20 year, and 30 year build out scenarios under the Broadway Plan Amendments. Date range: June 1, 2024 to December 13, 2024.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located.

The City confirms that the 3D computer model for the Broadway Plan itself is not a record as per the definition in Schedule 1 of the Act, "books, documents, maps, drawings, photographs, letters, vouchers, papers and any other thing on which information is recorded or stored by graphic, electronic, mechanical or other means, but does not include a computer program or any other mechanism that produces records". The 3D model itself is an approximate "point in time" draft which the City created by gleaning information from various City data, with assumptions and manipulations made for analytical purposes. The computer model under discussion is made up of data from various City sources and it requires a computer program to produce a three dimensional model.
