Subject: Worker safety incident at Stanley Park Train

## Hi Steve,

There was an employee safety incident tonight at the Stanley Park Train. My understanding from information received from Rosemary (who was offsite, but connected with Krysta) is that a driver suffered acute symptoms from the exhaust on one of the trains which required medical attention from first aid. First aid provided oxygen onsite, but was then taken to the hospital for further recovery. There were no known safety impacts for any guests.

Given this incident and information already known about the exhaust issues, I do not feel that the Stanley Park Train is currently a safe environment to work in for our drivers and recommend that we stop operations until a more comprehensive exhaust solution can be designed and implemented.

I've set up a mee ng to discuss the incident for 9.15am on Saturday morning (you, Godfrey, Rose and I are invited), so I'm hoping we can connect then and determine the path forward.


