- 1) Annual Supplement is a one time annual payment as approved under section 3.1 of the Mayor and Council Renumeration Bylaw 11483.
- 2) Local expenses represent costs incurred by the Mayor or Councillors while performing their official duties within Metro Vancouver, as authorized by section 4 of the Mayor and Councillor Expenses Bylaw 11529. These are non-personal business expenses and includes admission fees for community events, membership fees to fulfill civic duties, business equipment, expenses related to communications and other similar related expenses.
- 3) Travel and Training reflects expenses incurred while carrying out eligible activities outside of the Greater Vancouver Regional District, as authorized by sections 3.1 and 6 of the Mayor and Councillor Expenses Bylaw 11529. This category includes logistical costs associated with attending approved conferences and training as well as per diems for meals and incidentals.
- 4) The Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) is not exclusively taxpayer-funded; it is a non-profit organization supported through municipal membership fees and other funding sources.
- 5) Other Compensation includes Civic Theatre Tickets.
