On Friday evening, Vancouver Mural Festival advised City staff that they can no longer continue operations, and effective Friday, they have closed their doors. In sharing this news with City staff, VMF expressed appreciation for the City's support:

It created over 430 murals and engaged more than 505 artists (70% from equity-deserving groups). It partnered with Indigenous communities, local businesses, and non-profits to amplify marginalized voices and share stories through art. Over the years, VMF's work created meaningful work and generated more than \$4.6 million to artists."
