Dear Mayor and Council,

This memo provides an update on Web Summit Vancouver, a large-scale tech conference often referred to as "the Olympics for Tech," which will be held in Vancouver on May 27th to May 30th, at the Vancouver Convention Centre.

It is anticipated that approximately 15,000 participants from the global technology community will attend Web Summit Vancouver, focusing on promoting collaboration in technology, celebrating local companies and innovations and building networks of leads and partnerships. In conjunction with the main conference schedule, numerous affiliated and unaffiliated side events are organized by investors, foreign delegations, professional service firms, and government entities to support networking and promotion of a various business opportunities.

This memo provides information concerning opportunities for Council to attend the Web Summit Vancouver conference and related events, as well as some background on the conference.

Conference attendance

• Complimentary tickets are available to all members of Council.



- It is noted that these tickets (valued at \$730 each) provide offer "regular access,"
 which excludes access to the Speaker Lounge, official evening receptions, exhibition floor lounges, as well as food and beverage services.
- Web Summit speakers including the Mayor and Jessie Adcock (the City's FWC26 Host City Lead) – are provided with complimentary access to the event.

 - Tuesday, May 27th Taking place in downtown Vancouver, produced in collaboration with the Downtown Vancouver Business Improvement Association (DVBIA).
 - Wednesday, May 28th Taking place in downtown Vancouver, produced in collaboration with the Yaletown BIA.
 - o **Thursday, May 29**th Taking place at the Shipyards in North Vancouver.

• Staff will provide Council with further information concerning these events, as details are confirmed by the event organisers.

Conference-related events

- There are a significant number of official and unofficial events related to Web Summit Vancouver, which will offer networking and engagement opportunities for Vancouver businesses. These may include networking receptions, informal meet-ups, fireside chats, investor showcases, and start-up pitch sessions.
- Attachment 3 of this memo lists all such events, updated to May 7, 2025 including an event description, the date, time and location of each event, and registration links.
- Mayor and Council can attend many of these events, and may be invited to participate in these events directly by organizers.
- BEO staff will participate in many of these events in support of Vancouver businesses, in order to engage with investment leads and foreign delegations.

Leveraging Web Summit Vancouver

- Web Summit Vancouver presents opportunities for the City to support the Vancouver tech sector and broader business community, to profile the City's own technological successes, and to build awareness around opportunities related to hosting the FIFA World Cup in 2026 (FWC26).
- While Web Summit is responsible for staging this event, the "<u>Naturally Innovative Alliance</u>" partnership has been established to leverage Web Summit Vancouver. The mandate and membership of this partnership is contained in Attachment 1. This Alliance will have a pavilion at the Web Summit conference.
- The City Communications and Engagement team are working with the BEO to align key messages supporting active coverage of the event, and amplifying Vancouver-focused content over the duration of the week.
- For the past several months, the Business and Economy Office (BEO) has participated in efforts focused on industry engagement with the tech sector, with other levels of government, and with ecosystem partners, as part of the "Road to Web Summit" preparatory meetings.
 - These meetings, led by Innovate BC, have included hundreds of Vancouver-based tech companies and start-ups, as well as anchor companies such as Microsoft and Amazon.
 - Alongside these meetings, the City's Business and Economy Office is engaging with national and international delegations that will be bringing potential investment leads to the conference.

 During Web Summit Vancouver, City staff will engage directly with potential investors and business partners at the Naturally Innovative Alliance pavilion, using promotional materials prepared by Invest Vancouver.

2025-2027 Vancouver Collision Conference

- A. THAT Council receive an update on the bid that Destination Vancouver is leading to have Web Summit bring the Collision Conference ("Collision") to Vancouver in May 2025, May 2026 and May 2027 (the "Bid").
- B. Council approve the following financial and in-kind support as requested by Web Summit and the Bid Consortium for the 2025-2027 Collision Conference:
 - all conditional upon Web Summit awarding the Collision Conference to Destination Vancouver in 2025, 2026 and 2027;
 - all subject to the condition that a clause be included in the Bid proposal that is submitted
 to Web Summit that stipulates that the 2026 Collision Conference does not prevent the
 City in any way from fulfilling its contractual obligations as Host City for FIFA World Cup
 2026, and that the City's obligations, resources, and public space requirements
 associated with the FIFA World Cup 2026 event are prioritized over the Collision
 Conference in 2026: and
 - all subject to the other conditions described in this report:
 - i. a cash grant of up to \$250,000 in 2025, under Section 206(1)(g) of the Vancouver Charter to Destination Vancouver for Destination Vancouver to include in the Bid, with source of funds to be determined in the 2025 operating budget; and
 - ii. a value-in-kind offset grant of up to \$355,000 in each of 2025, 2026 and 2027, under Section 206(1)(g) of the Vancouver Charter to Web Summit in order to offset (waive) any Experiential Marketing and Private Event (EMPE) permit fees that the City may charge Web Summit for events it holds in outdoor City-owned public spaces; and
 - iii. a value-in-kind offset grant of up to \$10,000 in each of 2025, 2026 and 2027, under Section 206(1)(g) of the Vancouver Charter to Web Summit to waive the City's street banner application and rental fees in each of 2025, 2026, and 2027; and
 - iv. a value-in-kind offset grant of up to \$75,000 in each of 2025, 2026 and 2027, under Section 206(1)(g) of the Vancouver Charter to Web Summit to offset the City's operational and public safety costs Web Summit would hold in outdoor City-owned public spaces which would be a deviation from the City's policy for private and commercial events in outdoor City-owned public spaces described in the City of Vancouver Special Events Policy, with source of funds to be determined through annual operating budget process; and
 - v. Staff reiterate that further grants will not be considered beyond what has been included to date.

C. THAT Council delegate its authority to negotiate and execute any agreements with Destination Vancouver or Web Summit concerning the Bid and/or the Collision Conference to the City Manager or their delegate to bring effect any Council direction arising from this report, on the condition that any agreements accord with the details described in this report, and do not prevent the City from fulfilling its contractual obligations for FIFA World Cup 2026.

ATTACHMENT 2 WEB SUMMIT VANCOUVER BACKGROUND

- In December 2023, a Bid Consortium consisting of the City of Vancouver, the Province of BC, Destination Vancouver, the Vancouver Convention Centre, Invest Vancouver and the Frontier Collective submitted a preliminary Letter of Intent to bid for Collision 2025-2027 (now rebranded as Web Summit Vancouver).
- On April 9, 2024, Council approved the provision of one-time grant funding of \$250,000 in addition to three multi-year value in-kind offset grants totalling more than \$400,000 to secure the conference in Vancouver in conjunction with other partners.
- Destination Vancouver is the official Host Destination Organization for Web Summit Vancouver, and as such entered into a formal contract with Web Summit.
- Destination Vancouver has formed the collaborative partnership of the funding entities called the Naturally Innovative Alliance (NIA), a "... collaborative partnership between the Government of Canada, through Pacific Economic Development Canada (PacifiCan), Province of British Columbia, Innovate BC, Destination Vancouver, Invest Vancouver, and the City of Vancouver. Our goal is to increase worldwide awareness of the B.C. tech ecosystem and maximize opportunities for B.C.'s tech sector to benefit from Web Summit Vancouver, while helping foster strategic partnerships, investment, trade and jobs throughout the province."
 - o Members:
 - Destination Vancouver Michael Drake, Vice President
 - A non-profit, member-based destination management organization, transforming our communities and visitors through the power of travel.
 - PacifiCan David Tsui, Director-General
 - Federal agency supporting the growth and diversification of British Columbia's economy and advance the interests of the region in national economic policy, programs and projects. The Agency operates under the provision of the Western Economic Diversification Act, which came into force on June 28, 1988.
