In follow up to a number of questions from Council, our colleagues at BC Hydro along with staff from our Sustainability team have organized an offsite tour to provide an up-close view of the electrical infrastructure that powers our growing City. The tour will also provide an opportunity to speak directly with BC Hydro staff undertaking this work.

This tour will showcase multiplex electrical connections that demonstrate the impact of collaboration between the City and BC Hydro to make those service connections faster, more predictable and less costly. The tour will also include site visits to an electrical infrastructure projects underway, like the [Mount Pleasant Substation upgrade project](#), that support future growth within the city.
