SUBJECT: Upcoming Construction in the Shaughnessy Neighbourhood

The purpose of this memo is to provide an overview of the Shaughnessy Area Sewer Upgrade project, an externally delivered project that tie-ins into internally delivered sewer upgrades within the same area.

Background

The proposed works in the Shaughnessy neighbourhood will involve replacing 5.8 km of aging combined sewers. The project will improve service connection separation in the Cambie/Heather sewer sub-catchment, from 10% to 50%, while also replacing undersized sewer pipes to better accommodate future population growth and reduce flooding during high rainfall events.

Construction Schedule and impacts

The first construction phase in the Shaughnessy neighbourhood will begin with temporary watermain relocation within the Laneway West of Oak St. between W27th to W 29th Ave. Sewer main upgrades are expected to start in early September directly after watermain relocation is completed. Sewer work will then continue in three phases as outlined in Appendix 1 with expected completion in Q3 of 2026. All works are located within local streets with construction impacts primarily affecting adjacent residents.

Public Communication

Notification letters will be mailed to residents and businesses before City work is scheduled to begin. The letters will include information on scope, working hours, potential traffic impacts, detours, noise and vibration, and access to businesses and residences. Public liaison contact information will be provided for each project for general inquiries by the public. Please refer to Appendix 2 for a sample of the notification letter that will be mailed out.

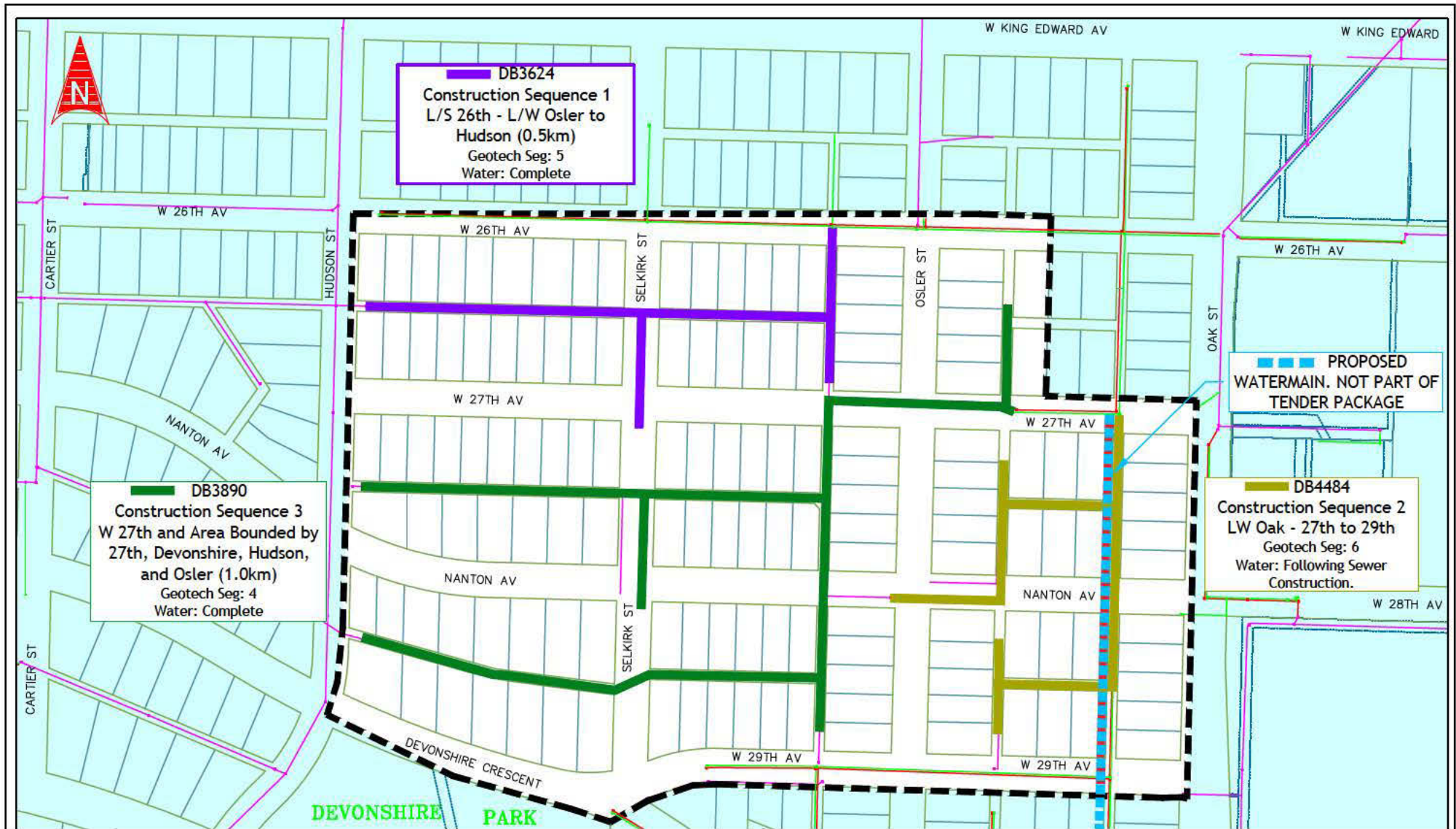

Dear Resident and Businesses:

RE: Sewer upgrades happening in your neighbourhood

Starting in July 2025, the City will begin upgrading aging combined sewer infrastructure in your neighborhood, starting on the lane west of Oak Street between W 27th and W 29th Avenue, then moving west into the Shaughnessy area.

The existing sewer system will be replaced with a separated and larger-capacity system, with one pipe for rainwater runoff and another pipe for sewage. This new system will help serve this growing neighborhood.

Construction will take place starting in July 2025 with expected completion by Spring 2026. Please note, this schedule is tentative and subject to change. The work will be carried out by Complete Utility Contractors (CUC) on behalf of the City of Vancouver. Once sewer construction is complete, permanent road restoration will follow.

What to Expect During Construction

Work Hours

Construction activities will occur Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with extended hours and weekend work scheduled as necessary. Please be advised that the schedule is subject to change.

Parking & Traffic Impacts:

Street and lane closures will be in effect to facilitate construction, with access maintained for residents and businesses whenever possible. Parking restrictions will be in effect to accommodate construction. Be sure to watch for road detours, “no parking” signs and bike detours as work takes place. Residents with electric vehicles should be aware that alternative charging arrangements may be necessary during this period.

Encroachments on City Right-of-Way

To reconnect your property to the new sewer mains, excavation and pipe installation may be required from the main sewer line to your property boundary.

If any encroachments - such as landscaping, paving stones, fences, planters, sprinklers, lighting, or electrical fixtures - are present, we will be in touch.

Please note: The City is not responsible for any damage to encroachments removed during construction, nor will it reinstall, replace, or repair these items, including driveway finishes.

Waste and Recycling Collection

Regular garbage and recycling collection schedule in your area will be maintained during construction. The crew on-site will communicate changes to you if your regular pickup or drop-off location become obstructed by the project.

Noise and Vibration:

Because of the nature of the work, noise, dust and vibrations are expected during construction. Efforts will be made to limit noise to within city noise by-law hours. Advance notice will be provided for any anticipated work outside of these hours with a noise by-law exception permit.

We apologize for any inconvenience and thank you in advance for your understanding and patience as we undertake these critical upgrades. Crews will take every precaution to minimize any inconvenience caused by construction.

Street Restoration

Upon completion of the sewer installation, your street will be permanently restored to City standards.
