We are please to invite you to a media event announcing the completion of a major expansion of the False Creek Neighbourhood Energy Utility (NEU). The media event will take place the morning of Thursday, October 16, 2025.

Note to attendees: This event will take place outside rain or shine. There will be an optional opportunity for brief tour inside the NEU facility following remarks.

At this event, we will share information about the expansion of the False Creek Neighbourhood Energy Utility, which supplies low-carbon thermal energy, mostly from recycled sewage and wastewater heat to buildings in Southeast False Creek, and now, after the completion of the expansion, parts of Mount Pleasant, and the False Creek Flats area.

Burning natural gas, a fossil fuel, in buildings accounts for nearly 60% per cent of the carbon pollution generated in Vancouver. The NEU provides a low-carbon alternative to natural gas and helps Vancouver to achieve its climate goals.

The project received funding from the Province of British Columbia (\$10.2M) as well as the Government of Canada (\$8.6M in financing as well as a grant of \$1.3M).
