Subject: Follow-up: AQ and pollution monitoring

Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

Further to the discussion this afternoon about air quality monitoring , I am able to provide some additional clarify from colleagues in Engineering Services.

Staff do not currently monitor air quality or pollution around school streets. This year, though, as part of the National Active School Streets Initiative (NASSI), UBC researchers will be monitoring air quality at the Lord Selkirk school street to better understand pollution outcomes.

Generally, air quality in the city and region is monitored by Metro Vancouver. Vancouver Coastal Health also leads specific studies on air quality as well as providing equipment for community to test air quality under the AQ-CARE program.

I hope this information helps clarify and please let me know if you require further information.
