I am responding to your request of February 18, 2025 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Records (such as correspondence, plans, and/or budgets) related to Granville Loop Park and the Granville Loop Park Tennis Courts, specifically addressing the:

- 1. Reason for the current tennis court closure;
- 2. Plan and budget of proposed tennis court maintenance work; and
- 3. Timeline of the tennis court closure.

Date range: January 1, 2024 to February 15, 2025

*Please note that Park Board staff have advised that the budget for maintenance falls under the overall operating budget for Downtown Parks & Beaches; this includes time allocated to assets based on a set schedule or reactive work, so there is no assigned budget.

Granville Loop Tennis Court Closure

Sequence of Events

- Jan. 15: Employee reports portions of courts are very slippery as he almost fell while carrying out maintenance (removing leaf and pine needle litter form courts). Courts closed. Interim signage put up and gates locked. Work order submitted for pressure washing. 'Courts Closed for Maintenance' signs ordered to reflect current situation
- Jan. 17: New signs collected. Waiting for completion notification for pressure washing work order. Courts remain closed for the next 6 weeks.
- Week of March 3: Informed that "power washing these color coated courts is only done on a 2 year maintenance schedule and if the courts should be closed during those months due to safety issues from all maintenance work not being resolved on a consistent basis than I think that is a great idea". Signage replaced and added to. March 6 Courts completely cleaned of tree litter. Blown and salt added to the worst of the algae spots.
- March 6: courts opened with signage stating "Slipper surfaces" and "Caution: Slippery when wet".
- Courts to be inspected weekly by Park Ops. Drainage, Court crews and coatings crews should be addressing everything that fall outside of the Park (Horticulture) Ops purview
