Re: **Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (The "Act")**

I am writing regarding your request of February 25, 2025 under the ***Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*** for:

Regarding the Bastid's BBQ 2018 event held on or about September 23, 2018 at or near the Hotel At The Waldorf (or in the parking lot, or some combination) at or near 1489 East Hastings Street:

- 1. The 2018 Liquor Licence application package and approval records;**
- 2. Records detailing the type of liquor licence issued in 2018, including any conditions, restrictions, and scope of service permitted;**
- 3. Incident or compliance reports related to liquor service at the 2018 event, particularly any reports concerning over-service or service to intoxicated patrons;**
- 4. Correspondence and communication between event organizers and the licensing authority regarding any of the above (specific to the 2018 event, but spanning 2018 to 2024); and**
- 5. Existing lists or indexes of documents that relate primarily to liquor service arrangements at the 2018 event.**

Date range: January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2024.

All responsive records are attached. Some information in the records has been severed (blacked out) under s.3(5)(a) and s.15(1) of the Act. You can read or download these sections here: http://www.bclaws.ca/EPLibraries/bclaws_new/document/ID/freeside/96165_00.

Please note that Business Licences can be obtained routinely for a fee from the Licence Office. Please find their contact information on their website here: <https://vancouver.ca/doing-business/get-a-business-licence.aspx>.

Please also note, the Manager or Property Use Inspections confirmed there are no records for point three of your request, and the Chief Licence Inspector noted the City does not review or determine if a location has over-served or served intoxicated patrons - the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch or Vancouver Police Department would be the likely holders of such records.

You may wish to request records directly from the Province of British Columbia and/or the Vancouver Police Department (VPD), both of which are separate public bodies under the Act. Please see the following websites to request records from the aforementioned organizations:

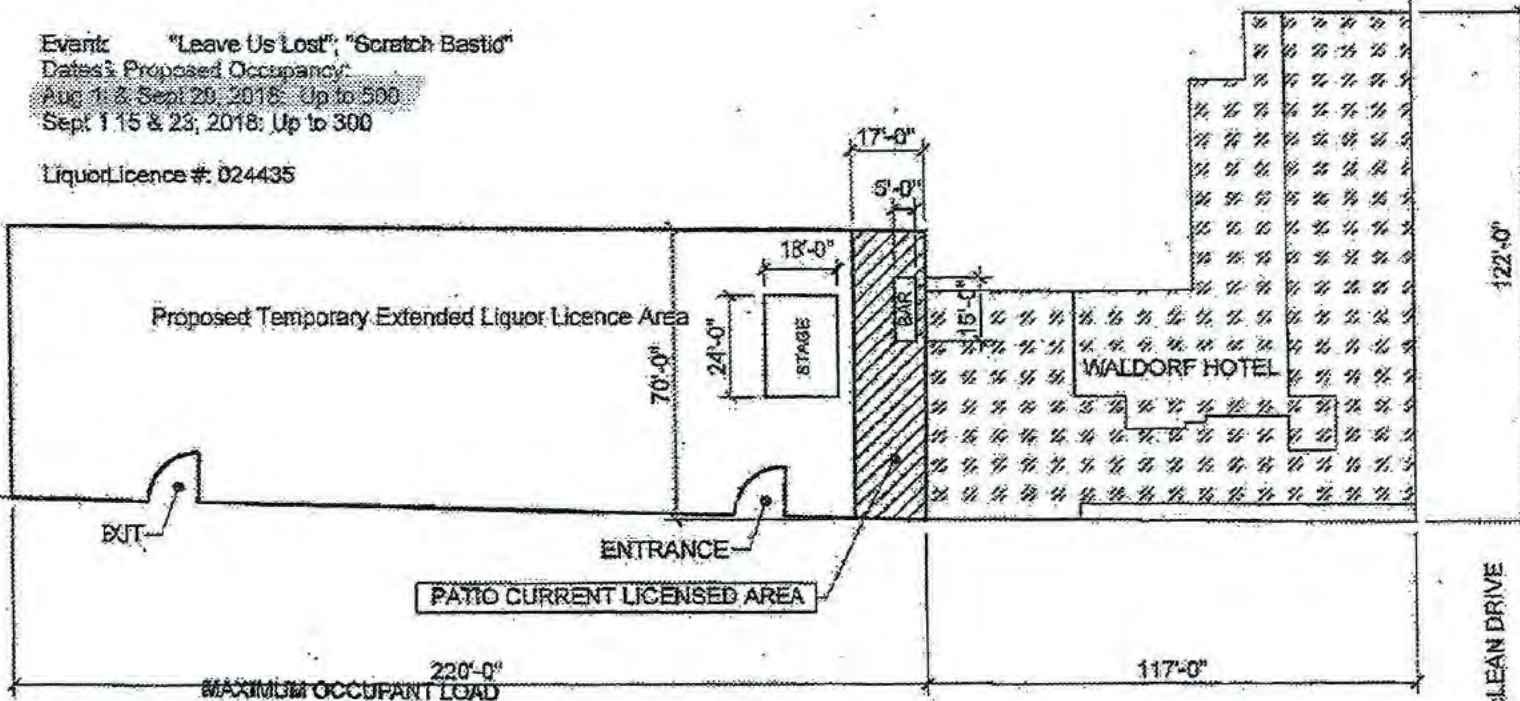

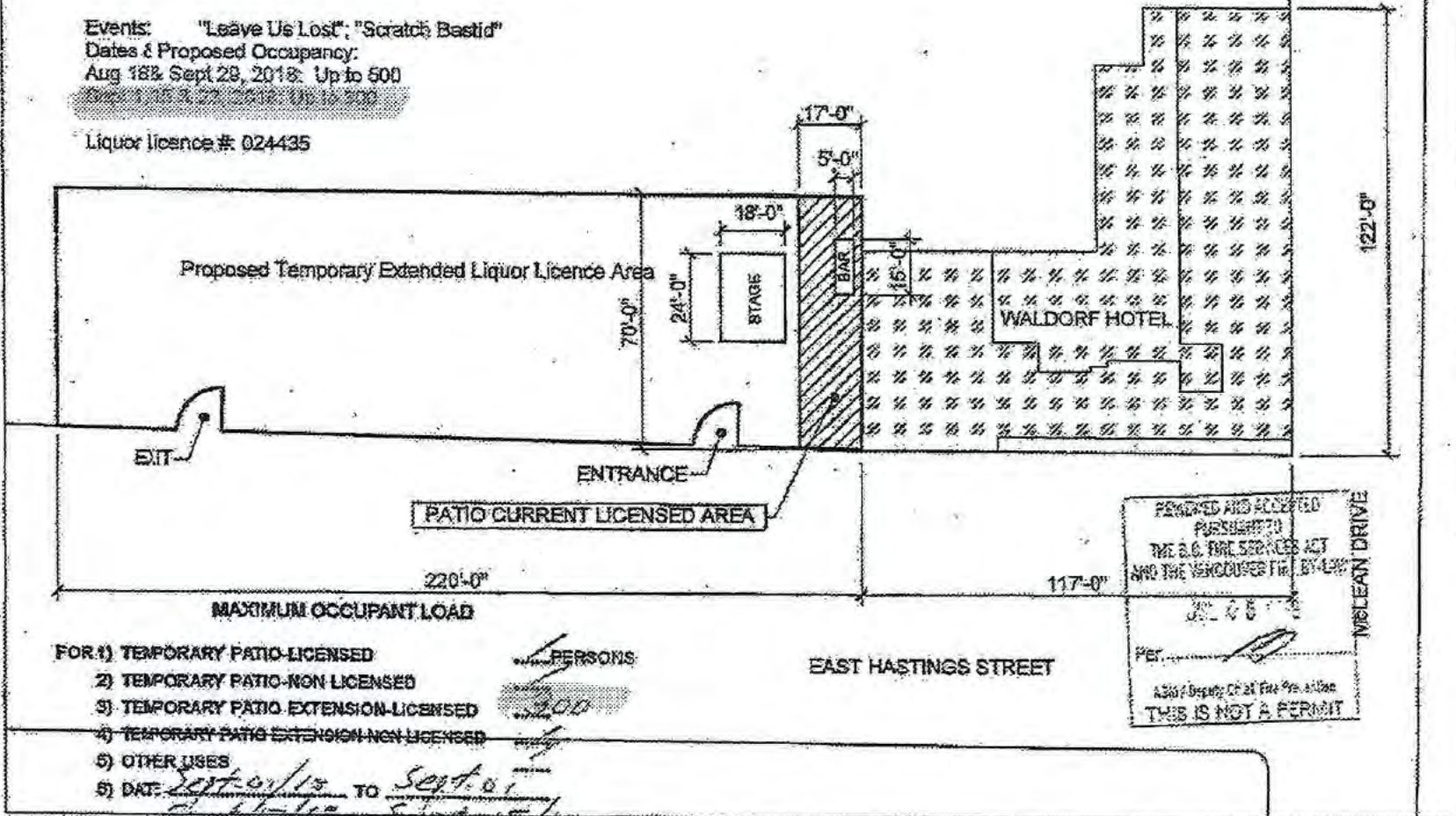

This letter is in response to your request for a Temporary Liquor Licence area extension to be held Hastings Club Hospitality Corp. located at 1489 E Hastings Street as per the attached floor plans. The temporary extension is approved for the following dates and time and subject to:

- i. Music levels at the property line (at the rear lane and Hastings Street not to exceed 70 dBC);
- ii. Sound readings to be taken on an hourly basis;
- iii. Maximum permitted capacity for the temporary area extension (DJ Dance Party) is **500 persons** for the events on **August 18 and September 29, 2018** and **300 persons** for **September 1, 15 and 23, 2018** as per the floor plans stamped by the Fire Department dated July 5, 2018.
- iv. At all times, sufficient security door staff shall be present at all entrances/exits into the extended area, to monitor patron behaviour and to control the movement of patrons between licensed areas;
- v. The patio area to be vacated of all patrons and cleaned by staff by the required closing time;
- vi. The extended area must be fenced (minimum 4 ft. high);
- vii. All fencing and patio furniture to be removed following the event;
- viii. The concurrence of the Liquor and Cannabis Regulation Branch; and
- ix. Food must be provided.

The Licensee is reminded that their interior Building Occupant Load must be complied with at all times. As such, if the interior licensed space is at capacity when the extension area closes, then patrons in the extension area must not be permitted access into the building.

If complaints are received, this approval may be reviewed or cancelled and future temporary change requests may not be granted.

Please note that Health By-law No. 9535 prohibits smoking on patios.

I have no objection to the above request and support this change on a temporary basis as outlined.

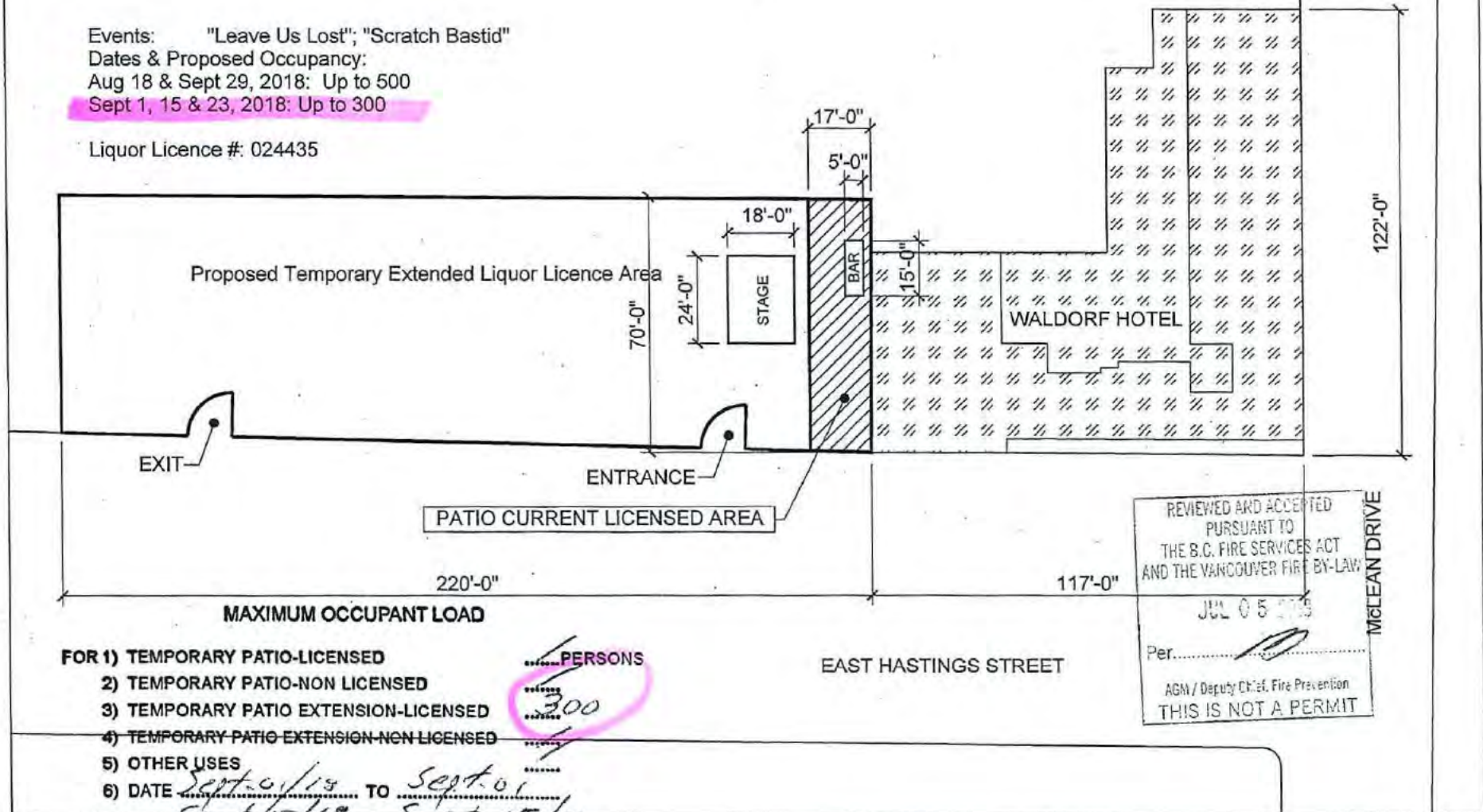



Part 13: What Happens Next?

The temporary change application process:

1. If the requested temporary change(s) require local government/First Nation comment, the applicant must take the completed application form and all required documents to their local government/First Nation and request that the local government/First Nation complete and sign Part 12.
2. The applicant will submit the signed application, all required documents and application fee to the Victoria Head Office (LCLB).

Note: Applicants must ensure they submit their completed application a minimum of three (3) weeks (or two (2) months, if it's a request for discretion - see Part 9) before the proposed change. Otherwise, your application will not be accepted and will be returned to you.

3. The LCLB licensing staff will review the application package and advise the applicant by phone, mail or fax, of any information or documents required before the application can be processed.
4. LCLB licensing staff will request comments from the local liquor inspector.
5. If required, the local liquor inspector will work with the applicant on security and related issues.
6. LCLB licensing staff will review the comments from the local government/First Nation (if applicable) and local liquor inspector.
7. LCLB staff will contact the applicant by, fax or mail to let them know whether or not the change has been approved. The applicant will receive LCLB's decision in writing.
