## RE: Residential Parking – Parking Survey Results for 700 W 66th Av

Dear Resident:

The parking survey for your block is now closed and has indicated that:

16% **support** the installation of permit parking regulations

14% did not support the installation of permit parking regulations

70% did not respond to the survey

Since less than 51% of block households have voted in favour of installing regulations, the survey has **NOT PASSED**.

The RPO regulations will be removed from the block in the coming months and the street will become unregulated.
