Re: **Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")**

I am responding to your request of August 27, 2025 under the ***Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*** for:

Record of counterflow camera footage on the Lions Gate Bridge from 7:30 pm to 7:45 pm on August 21, 2025 regarding a collision on the North Vancouver side between a motorcycle and pickup truck.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located. Traffic and Data Management staff have confirmed the City has no video footage responsive to your request.

Please note, you may wish to request records or footage directly from the Ministry of Transportation or the District of West Vancouver, as the area of the bridge you have referenced may be within their jurisdiction, and they are considered separate public bodies under the Act.
