**Regarding the PNE Amphitheatre, aka Freedom Mobile Arch, record of the 12-year sponsorship agreement, which includes venue naming rights, with Quebecor, Videotron, Freedom Mobile and/or UNITE Partnerships. Note: record may be under the custody and/or control of PNE Chair Councillor Mike Klassen and/or Vice-Chair Park Board GM Steve Jackson.**
