The City of Vancouver contributed land and capital funding for this important housing development. The project is a partnership between the City of Vancouver, CMHC, the Province, through BC Housing, the Community Land Trust and Atira. The site has been leased to the Community Land Trust, which has partnered with Atira to provide housing operations.
