Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of February 27, 2026 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Record of whether the Granville strip around the intersection of 900 block of Granville St & Smithe St was closed off for cars to allow for pedestrian use during the evening of April 20, 2025. Date range: March 1, 2025 to April 21, 2025.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located. Engineering Services staff have advised that the evening/nighttime closures for the Granville entertainment district are managed by the Vancouver Police Department (VPD).
