Re: **Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")**

I am responding to your request dated April 30, 2026 under the ***Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*** for:

Description of requested information: The following records related to **Street Use Permit SU-2025-01205 (2212 Marstrand Avenue)**, including all approved plans and supporting materials governing construction access, staging, and traffic management:

1. **Approved Street Use Permit drawings and conditions, including all attachments and referenced documents;**
2. **Traffic Management Plan (TMP) and/or Construction Management Plan (CMP) associated with this permit;**
3. **Truck routing plans, including any designated access routes, restrictions, or conditions of use;**
4. **Approved staging and loading plans, including locations for construction vehicles, equipment, and material handling;**
5. **Any conditions, analyses, or internal requirements related to:**
 - a) **minimum roadway clearance;**
 - b) **emergency vehicle access;**
 - c) **pedestrian safety and passage;**
 - d) **interaction with garbage collection or other service operations; and**
 - e) **Internal Engineering review comments, approvals, or correspondence related to the above, including review by Transportation, Street Use, or Fire Services, where applicable.**

Date range: January 1, 2026 to April 29, 2026.

Engineering Services staff within the Development and Major Projects Branch have advised our office that the record responsive to your request is currently in a draft form and is undergoing comment and review and is not yet finalized. Therefore, the information you are requesting is

Staff have also advised our office that the records you have requested largely occur much later in the permit process.
