Dear Mayor and Council,

You are invited to a media event to announce the opening of a new Indigenous-focused housing development at 375 Glen Drive. The building will provide nearly 200 homes, including non-market units, market rental units, transitional homes and shelter beds with associated services.

Please note: the Province is leading event coordination and selected the event date.

This project is a partnership with the City of Vancouver, CMHC, the Province, Aboriginal Housing Management Association (AHMA) and Vancouver Aboriginal Friendship Centre Society (VAFCS). The City contributed approximately \$4.6 million in capital funding, as well as land for the project valued at approximately \$13.3 million.
