You may notice that the City will be posting non-partisan civic education and election awareness content across its social media channels (Facebook, X (formerly Twitter), Instagram, Threads, and LinkedIn). Candidate and political party accounts must not comment on or reply to the City's election-related social media posts to maintain the non-partisan nature of these communications.

For any questions related to the Local Elections Campaign Financing Act, please contact Elections BC at 1.855.952.0280. The nomination period begins on September 1, at 9 am and ends on September 11, at 4 pm.

Candidates are strongly encouraged to make an appointment to submit their nomination documents. Appointments for September 1 to 11, will be available for booking starting on August 17, by calling 604.829.2010. Nomination documents will be accepted at the Vancouver Election Office located at 305 West 8th Avenue. Road closures nearby may affect parking near the Election Office, please call ahead to plan your visit at 604.829.2010.

Instructions for Completing the Nomination Documents

1.0 Completing the Nomination Documents

All nomination documents must be received by the close of the nomination period (September 11, at 4 pm). Refer to the Quick Reference Guide to Nomination Documents for information on which documents are mandatory. Note: Candidates for School Trustee complete a different set of forms (CS1-CS6) than other candidates (C1-C6). You can download an electronic version of the nomination documents at: <https://vancouver.ca/your-government/run-for-office-in-vancouver.aspx>.

Nomination documents may be delivered by hand, mail, or other delivery service to 305 West 8th Avenue, Vancouver BC, V5Y 1N6, or you may email your nomination documents to electioncandidates@vancouver.ca, prior to the close of the nomination period.

To avoid delays in filing nomination documents, it is highly recommended that candidates make an appointment for filing the documents by calling the Election Office, at 604.829.2010. Appointment bookings will commence on August 17.

Candidates must make a solemn declaration on the documents. The declaration can be taken by a lawyer, notary or Commissioner for Taking Affidavits for British Columbia, but is usually taken by the Chief Election Officer or designate at the time the nomination papers are filed. When making the solemn declaration, please ensure you bring one piece of government issued identification. Emailed nomination papers must include the completed solemn declaration.

Nominations must be accompanied by a \$100 deposit in cash, certified cheque or bank draft payable to the City of Vancouver. The deposit will be returned after campaign financing disclosure statements are filed with Elections BC or if you withdraw as a candidate before the candidate withdrawal deadline.

Form C2/CS2 must be completed in full. If your “usual name” is not the same as your legal name, and you wish to have the usual name used on the ballot, print your usual name on the appropriate line. Note that an elector, another nominee or the Chief Election Officer may initiate a legal challenge of your nomination on the basis that the “usual name” you have entered on your nomination papers is not, in fact, your usual name.

Please note that the following information cannot appear on the ballot: an indication that the candidate is holding or has held an elected office; the candidate’s occupation; or an indication of a title, honour, degree or decoration received or held by the candidate (*Vancouver Charter*, section 77(3)). The candidate’s last name will appear in all capital letters on the ballot.

A minimum of 25 nominators must sign your nomination documents (refer to the table below for nominator eligibility requirements). If there is any doubt about a nominator’s qualifications, that nominator will not be counted, and your nomination may be challenged. To avoid a potential challenge you are encouraged to collect more than 25 signatures, so additional space is provided. As indicated on the forms, the names of your nominators will be made available for public inspection; addresses, except for the name of the municipality, will be redacted.

Who can be a nominator?

A nominator must be a qualified elector of the City of Vancouver and, on or before General Voting Day (October 17, 2026), must meet all the following requirements:

1. Be 18 years of age or older on October 17, 2026
2. Be a Canadian citizen
3. Have been a resident of B.C. for at least six months immediately before the day of registration
4. For non- resident property electors, have been a registered owner of real property in Vancouver for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration
5. Not be disqualified from voting in an election under any enactment or otherwise disqualified by law

For School Trustee candidates:

Nominators must be qualified electors of School District No. 39 (Vancouver), which includes the City of Vancouver, the University Endowment Lands, and UBC Lands.

2.0 Completing the Statement of Financial Disclosure

Under the British Columbia *Financial Disclosure Act*, candidates for the position of Mayor, Councillor and School Trustee must complete and file a Statement of Financial Disclosure form with their nomination documents.

Note that the Statement of Financial Disclosure is different from the Campaign Financing Disclosure Statement, which must be filed after the election.

If you have questions about the Statement of Financial Disclosure form, it is suggested that you seek financial or legal counsel.

3.0 Candidate Information

Election candidates are invited to submit their contact and social media information for inclusion on the candidates' page on the City of Vancouver website. **Submission deadline: September 11 at 4pm.**

4.0 Obtaining a List of Registered Electors

Under section 35(8) of the *Vancouver Charter*, each nominated candidate is entitled to receive one copy of the list of registered electors at no charge. The list will be provided electronically along with other documents, such as the map of voting places.

The list of registered electors contains confidential personal information and is provided exclusively for purposes related to the 2026 General Local Election. The *Vancouver Charter* establishes significant penalties for the unauthorized use or disclosure of this information. Candidates are responsible for ensuring that the list is stored securely and accessed only by authorized individuals.

Before receiving the list of registered electors, candidates must sign a declaration confirming that the information will be used only for purposes permitted under the *Vancouver Charter*. The list will be provided on September 18.

All copies of the list of registered electors must be destroyed within 8 weeks following the election.

CANDIDATE NOMINATION PACKAGE

Use the Candidate Cover Sheet and Checklist Form C1 to ensure that the Candidate Nomination Package is complete and meets the legislative requirements of the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, *Financial Disclosure Act* and *Vancouver Charter*.

The Candidate Cover Sheet and Checklist Form C1 serve as a guide to the forms that must be submitted by a Candidate, their Official Agent and/or their Financial Agent to the Chief Election Officer as part of the nomination process.

Ensure that, for each item checked off on the Checklist Form C1 (Section B), the relevant form is completed and attached.

NOTE: Candidate Nomination documents can be submitted to the Chief Election Officer in-person, by mail, by fax or by email. Local government contact information is available online at: <https://www/civicinfo.bc.ca/directories>

The Candidate Cover Sheet and Checklist Form C1 are for the Chief Election Officer's reference only and do not constitute part of the Candidate Nomination Package.

Completing only the Candidate Cover Sheet and Checklist Form C1 **does not** constitute completion of the Candidate Nomination Package, nor does it satisfy the legislative requirements set out in the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, *Financial Disclosure Act* and *Vancouver Charter*.

COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Record the Candidate's full name.
2. Record the office for which the Candidate is seeking election.
3. Use section B of the Candidate Cover Sheet and Checklist Form C1 to identify which forms have been completed and are included in the Candidate Nomination Package.
4. Return the completed package to the Chief Election Officer.

RE: Information Regarding Election & Political Signage in the City of Vancouver

Placement of election and political signage in the City of Vancouver is regulated under the Sign By-law and Street and Traffic By-law. The following information outlines the City's approach to election and political signage to assist you in complying with these regulations. Election signs are permitted starting 45 days prior to general voting day.

Signs on Public Property

Signs on street right-of-way are regulated by the Street and Traffic By-law:

- Election and political signage is **not** permitted on City property including:
 - the area between the sidewalk and the street
 - boulevards or street centre medians (including on Boundary Road)
 - poles
 - structures such as utility boxes or post boxes
 - sidewalks and roadways
 - within 100m from a Voting Place on General Voting Day
- Exceptions
 - Election and political signage may be placed on City property during an election between the back of sidewalk and the adjoining private property with permission of the property owner.
 - Election and political material may be posted using the City's poster cylinders located on designated lamp standards throughout the city. For locations, please visit: <https://vancouver.ca/doing-business/posters-and-signs-on-city-property.aspx>
- Impounding of signs
 - All improperly placed signs and posters on City property will be impounded and stored at Engineering Services, 5th floor, 507 W Broadway at the expense of the party or candidate. Removed signs may be retrieved from this location between

9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. Please call or email in advance to arrange an appointment. The minimum impoundment fee is \$100.00 per sign and may increase depending on the staff time and equipment required.

Signs on Private Property

Signs on private property are regulated by the Sign By-law:

- Election or political signs on private property
 - Freestanding signs smaller than 3.0m² do not require a permit.
 - One window sign per address is allowed without a permit, provided it does not cover more than 30% of the window's glass surface.
 - May be displayed on:
 - The day a federal or provincial election is announced; or
 - 45 days before a municipal election vote or referendum.
- Election signs must be removed 48 hours after the close of voting.

Campaign Financing Disclosure Statements

Elector organizations must file a candidate disclosure statement with Elections BC by **Friday, January 15, 2027**. You may file your disclosure statement up to 120 days after general voting day (by Monday, February 15, 2027); however, you will be subject to a \$500 late filing fee.

Your elector organization disclosure statement must include a full accounting of your campaign contributions, election expenses, and any monetary transfers between campaign accounts. Your disclosure statement will be published online by Elections BC following the filing deadline. **You may be subject to severe penalties if you do not file a disclosure statement.**

The \$100 nomination deposit will be returned upon completion of the candidate disclosure statement with Elections BC.
