

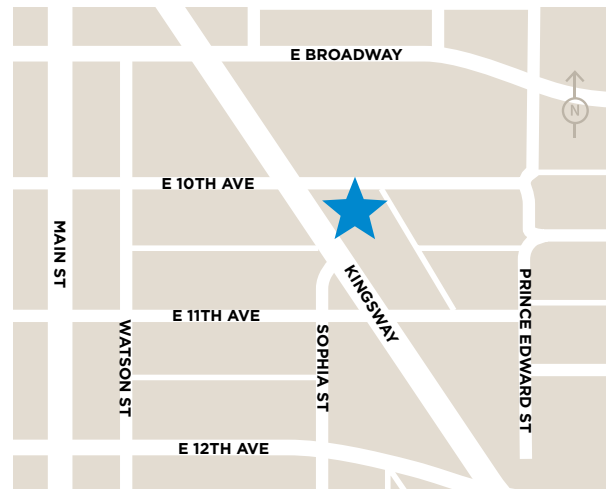


New warm, safe homes with supports at **205 Kingsway**

Vancouver is in a housing crisis and more than 2,000 people across the city are experiencing homelessness. Creating warm, safe homes with supports for people experiencing or at risk of homelessness in our communities continues to be a top priority for the City of Vancouver and our Provincial and Federal government partners.

With funding support from the Federal and Provincial governments, the City has purchased the property at 205 Kingsway with the intention of renovating the building to provide approximately **68 units** with supports for people experiencing homelessness.

Supportive housing saves lives by providing professional health and wellness supports such as meals, medical care and life skills training, offered both on site and in the local community.



Bringing people inside means there are fewer people outside struggling to survive. When a person chooses to live in supportive housing, they:

- have a warm, safe place to call home
- can access the necessities of life such as food, washrooms and laundry
- can begin to heal from the damage caused by living outside
- can reconnect to community
