RE: 49th Avenue Transit Improvements

Dear resident or business owner,

We are writing to provide an update about the bus lanes on 49th Avenue between Cambie Street and Fraser Street.

Starting in fall 2026 bus lanes on both sides of 49th Avenue will be installed in coordination with roadway restoration. Operating hours for these bus lanes will be from **7am to 7pm, Monday to Saturday** (see map on p. 3). Parking will be restricted during all hours that the bus lanes are in operation.

These changes will help buses move smoothly through traffic and support faster and more reliable bus service for thousands of transit riders.

What we heard

In February 2026, we asked the public and businesses for feedback on the proposed bus lane hours (7am to 10pm, seven days a week) along 49th Avenue between Cambie and Fraser Streets. Feedback highlighted a mix of priorities including loss of parking, requests for longer bus lane hours, and accessibility considerations.

What we're doing

Based on feedback received, we are making the following changes to the project:

- Adjusting the bus lane hours on 49th Avenue between Cambie Street and Fraser Street to 7am – 7 pm, Monday to Saturday

- Adding loading zones next to 49th Avenue on side streets:
 - Most streets between Cambie Street and Fraser Street will have one loading zone on each side that can be accessed from 49th Avenue. Loading zones can be used for up to 3 minutes to load and unload passengers or up to 30 minutes to load and unload goods
- Surveying residents on 49th Avenue and surrounding blocks about possible permit parking zones:
 - Permit parking zones will be introduced if most responses are in favour.
 - Residents within a potential permit parking zone will receive a separate letter with the survey details and are encouraged to respond.

Next Steps

We will continue to keep you informed about the progress of the project. In May 2026, we are planning to launch engagement for bus lanes on 49th Avenue from Fraser Street to Boundary Road. Notifications will be distributed to businesses and residents within that project area.

Map of Changes on 49th Avenue from Cambie Street to Fraser Street

7AM - 7PM, Mon to Sat bus lanes

- Adding **new bus lanes** on 49th Ave between Cambie St and Fraser St.
- Existing bus lanes on the north side of 49th Ave approaching Main St **extended** from weekday AM/PM peak periods to **7AM - 7PM, Monday to Saturday**.
- **Parking restricted** during bus lane hours.
- Other high occupancy vehicles (HOVs) are **not permitted** to use the bus lane.
