
## Comox - Jervis to Thurlow Proposed Design





WHAT IS DIFFERENT?	WHY?
One-way street eastbound for vehicles between Bute and Thurlow	To reduce vehicle volumes while maintaining access for residents and emergency vehicles
One-way painted counterflow bike lane between Thurlow and Bute	<ul> <li>To provide a comfortable cycling environment suitable for people of all ages and abilities</li> <li>To maintain emergency vehicle access</li> </ul>
Corner bulges at Bute and Thurlow	<ul> <li>To prevent short-cutting of vehicle traffic</li> <li>To provide improved pedestrian crossings</li> </ul>
Switch stop signs at Bute	To give traffic on Comox the priority
New sidewalk on the north side of Comox between Jervis and Thurlow	To improve accessibility for pedestrians
Upgrade intersection lighting	To improve visibility for all road users
New pedestrian lighting	To improve visibility for all road users
Curb ramps	To provide accessible pedestrian crossings
Seating areas	To provide resting opportunities
