SUBJECT : Andy Livingstone Park Service Overview – Board Briefing Memo

Dear Commissioners,

With the recent incident at Andy Livingstone Park, the following information is to provide you with the current resources that are focused on park cleanliness and security in Andy Livingstone Park and the surrounding area.

Security Attendants (Park Board staff) for Andy Livingstone and Creekside playgrounds and washrooms:

- 5 days per week, 8 hours per day Monday to Friday;
- Weekend: two-person team attends to the playgrounds; and
- Attendants pick up an average of 200 needles per week.

Horticulture staff

- 5 days per week, from 7:00am to 3:30pm Monday to Friday; and
- Sweep the park daily for needles and garbage before doing horticulture work.

Park Rangers

- 7 days per week;
- 7:00am start shift with a briefing at Stanley Ranger Station; and
- 7:30am team of 2 Rangers arrive at Andy Livingstone Park for a full park patrol that includes the following:
 - wake-up anyone the Security Attendants could not wake;
 - remove encampments;
 - pick-up needles, deal with open drug use and drug dealing;
 - Crosstown playground first priority;
 - team of 2 Rangers do an afternoon sweep of the park; and
 - Rangers attend to calls from 311, VanConnect and through the Dispatch Center on a priority basis.
