#2	Saturday, September 11 (9am to 2pm)	The second pop-up will be set up in a stall at the <u>West End Farmer's Market</u> on September 11, from 9am to 2pm. This will generate exposure for the project at a prominent and popular West End event.
#3	Tuesday, September 28 & Wednesday, September 29 (late afternoon/ evening)	The third pop-up will be at Morton Park at the end of Davie Street in the late afternoon to early evenings on September 28 and 29. This event is intended to reach visitors of Denman / Davie Villages, including pedestrian and bike traffic on the western portion of the site near English Bay.
#4	Friday, October 1 (4pm to 6pm)	The final pop up would be during the Fall Go By Bike Week at a station on Beach Avenue and Jervis Street, tentatively scheduled for Friday, October 1 from 4pm to 6pm, to be confirmed with event staff closer to the date.
