What's being considered at this Public Engagement?

At the direction of City Council, the City of Vancouver is undertaking a governance review of Hastings Park and is interested in your input on three draft potential options to replace the existing structure.

Your input is important. It will assist in developing refined options for public feedback in April 2013. City Council will then consider final option(s) in June.

## Why are we here today?

- To talk about the importance of good governance and how it supports implementation of the Council-approved Hastings Park/PNE Master Plan
- To review and discuss the draft potential governance options that have been developed based on leading practices and input to date
