



AGENCY PASS Eligibility and Terms of Use

OVERVIEW

The Agency Pass is issued in the name of the agency/organization and program. The Agency Pass allows staff and volunteers at non-profit agencies and government services to accompany their clients, who reside in the City of Vancouver to basic Vancouver Park Board recreation services.

- Passes are not eligible at Sunset Community Centre - Fitness Centre.

AGENCY PASS GROUP BENEFITS ARE DIFFERENT FROM LEISURE ACCESS PROGRAM INDIVIDUAL BENEFITS

- If your clients qualify for the Leisure Access Program agency can refer them with the 3rd Party Referral application.

PASS DISTRIBUTION TO STAFF/ VOLUNTEERS

When distributing an Agency pass, please ensure that the pass number is recorded and linked to the individual receiving the pass, and staff / volunteer understand and agree to the Terms of Use.

ELIGIBILITY

Agency passes are available to organizations that meet the following criteria:

- Non-profit and government agencies serving residents of Vancouver who are low-income;
- Organizations / programs that receive support from the City of Vancouver's Childcare Enhancement Grant are also eligible unless operated by a Vancouver Community Centre Association (CCA) / Board of Management.

TERMS OF USE

- Agency passes are not transferable between agencies
- Agency passes are not for personal use of staff and volunteers
- Benefits only extend to the Agency's staff/volunteer when accompanying their clients to recreation services at Vancouver Park Board and participating CCA facilities
- The Agency staff / volunteer, in a participatory or supervisory role, should always be in the same room as their clients
- If client's are 8 years old or younger they should be within arm's reach of staff/ volunteer
- **Staff are to bring their Agency pass to the facility cashier** who will scan your pass and request the number of staff/volunteers (16 or older) and clients attending
- **Client/ staff ratios must be followed** (see table on next page)
- There is \$5.00 charge for each replacement card (with a new pass number, but the same expiry date) if lost prior to renewal. Cards are replaced at the Leisure Access Office LAP@vancouver.ca
- **If attending with 10 or more clients for indoor public swim, or public skate sessions contact the recreation facility in advance to make a group booking by calling 3-1-1**
