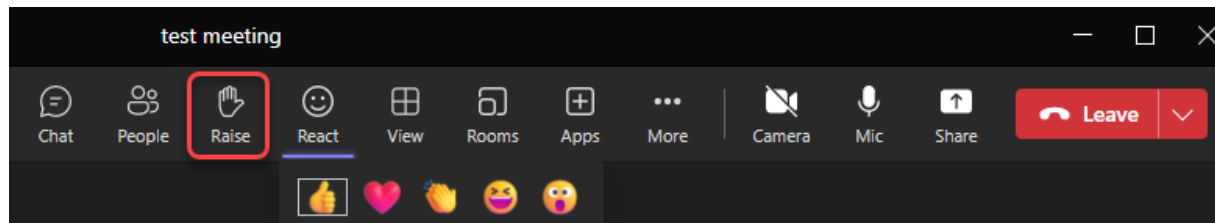

Policy Overview

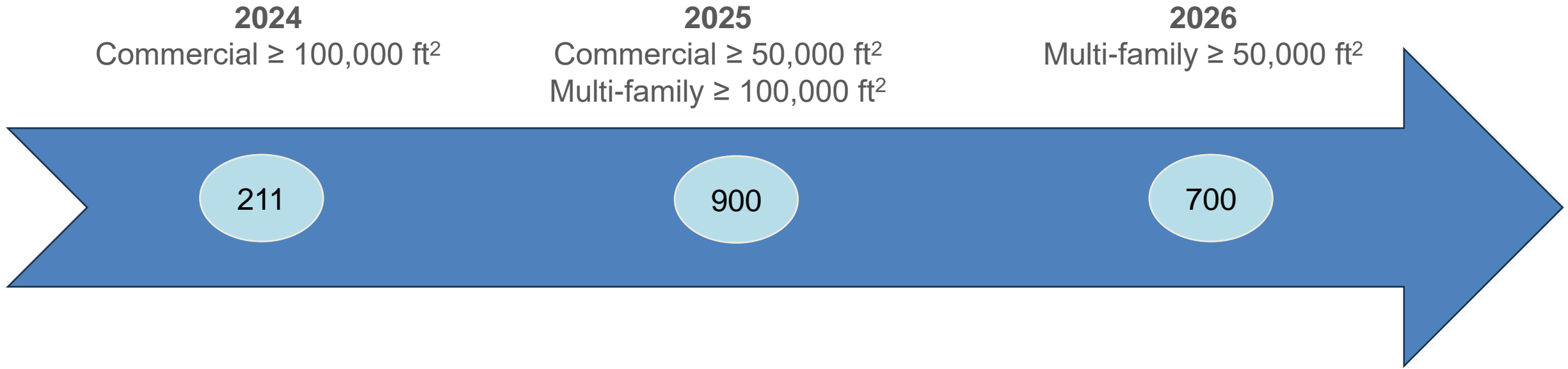


Annual GHG and Energy Limits By-Law

- Establishes energy and carbon reporting rules for large commercial & residential and hotel buildings
 - Energy & Carbon Reporting (ECR)
 - Commercial & residential and hotel buildings $\geq 50,000$ ft²
- Goal to cut emissions from all buildings 50% by 2030 and 100% by 2050



Energy & Carbon Reporting (ECR) Timeline



GHGI & HEI Limits for Office & Retail > 100k ft²

2026

Office GHGI = 25kg CO₂e/m²/year

Retail GHGI = 14kg CO₂e/m²/year

2040

GHGI = 0 kg CO₂e/m²/year

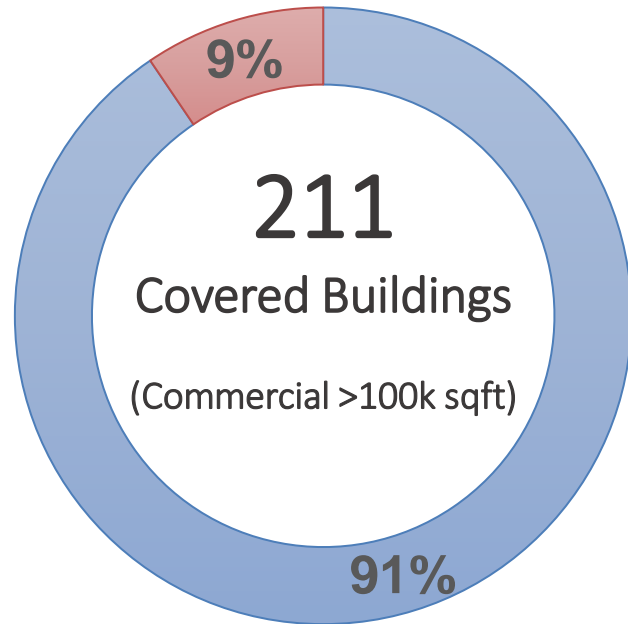
HEI = 0.09 GJ/m²/year

Requirement	Timeline
ECR Report	Starting with 2024 submission; Annually (June 1)
Carbon Emissions Operating Permit	Starting in 2027; Annually (Aug 1)
Third-Party Certification	Starting in 2027; Every 4 years (June 1)

2024 Compliance Rate

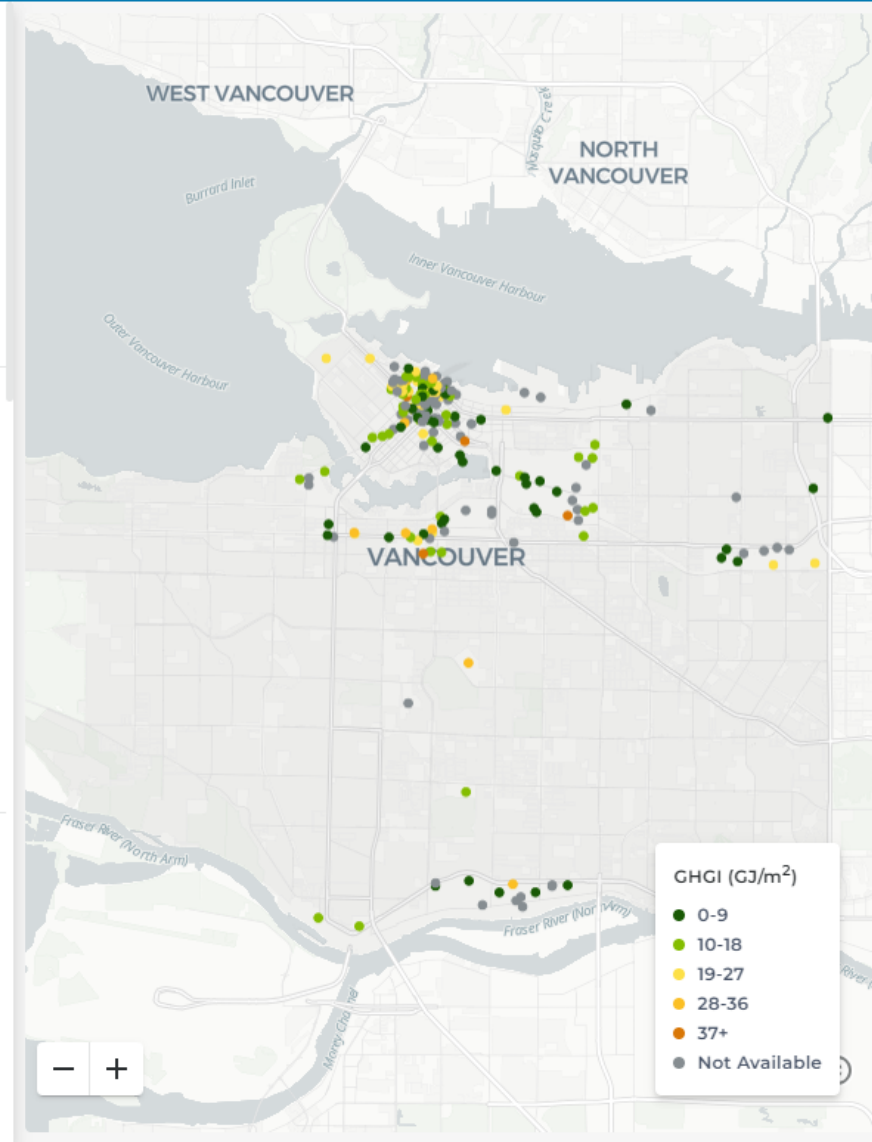
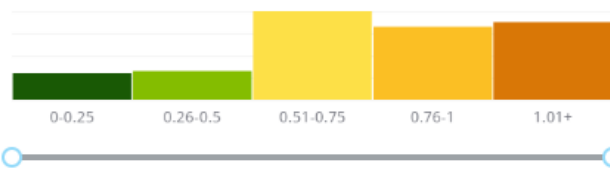

Energy and Carbon Reporting Compliance

To comply in 2025, commercial buildings 50,000 ft² & residential and hotel buildings 100,000 ft² and larger must **submit an annual energy and carbon report** containing building energy use from the previous calendar year **by June 1**

- All reports will be reviewed and owners will be notified of the report status by email
 - **Pending Revisions:** Report contains errors. To reach compliance, the owner must resubmit an updated report or provide an explanation for the errors identified.
 - **In Compliance:** No errors are found and report is approved.
