



## **Permitted Artists in Parks COVID SAFETY GUIDELINES**

Hello Vancouver Park Board Artists' Permit holders.

Park Board has been working to understand measures that should be in place to keep you, the public and our staff safe during the ongoing COVID 19 pandemic. As part of these efforts, we are requesting that you **read the required safety measures detailed below and confirm your agreement to work within these guidelines.**

- Your work will take place outdoors only
- You are asymptomatic and, to your knowledge, have not been in contact with anyone ill
- You have not travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days
- You understand the site size requirement for your work space is 6m x 2m (20' x 6')
- You will ensure that your work space is 2m distant from any other artist set up in your zone
- You will work to ensure consistent physical distance of 2m between patrons/viewers
- You will not share art supplies
- You will not share food or drink
- Hand-washing and/or hand sanitizer must be available
- Portrait artists must maintain a physical distance of 2m between artist and sitter
- As necessary, Portrait artists will keep a wait list with approximate appointment times for prospective clients in order to avoid line-ups
- Portrait artists must sanitize client seat with 60% alcohol wipe after each sitting

**I have read the above safety actions and guidelines for artists creating and selling work in Vancouver Parks and agree to follow them.**
