- e) The Director of Legal Services, Chief Purchasing Official and Engineering Services Department General Manager are recommended to be authorized to execute and deliver all legal documents on behalf of the City.
- f) The Bid Committee's approval is pre-contract execution, the final contract terms may vary subject to final negotiations and contract execution
