RE: Upgrades to the Central Valley Greenway: Clark Drive to John Hendry Park

The Central Valley Greenway is a 25-kilometre active transportation route that connects Vancouver, Burnaby, and New Westminister. The greenway is a key route for regional and local commuting and recreational travel (see map below).



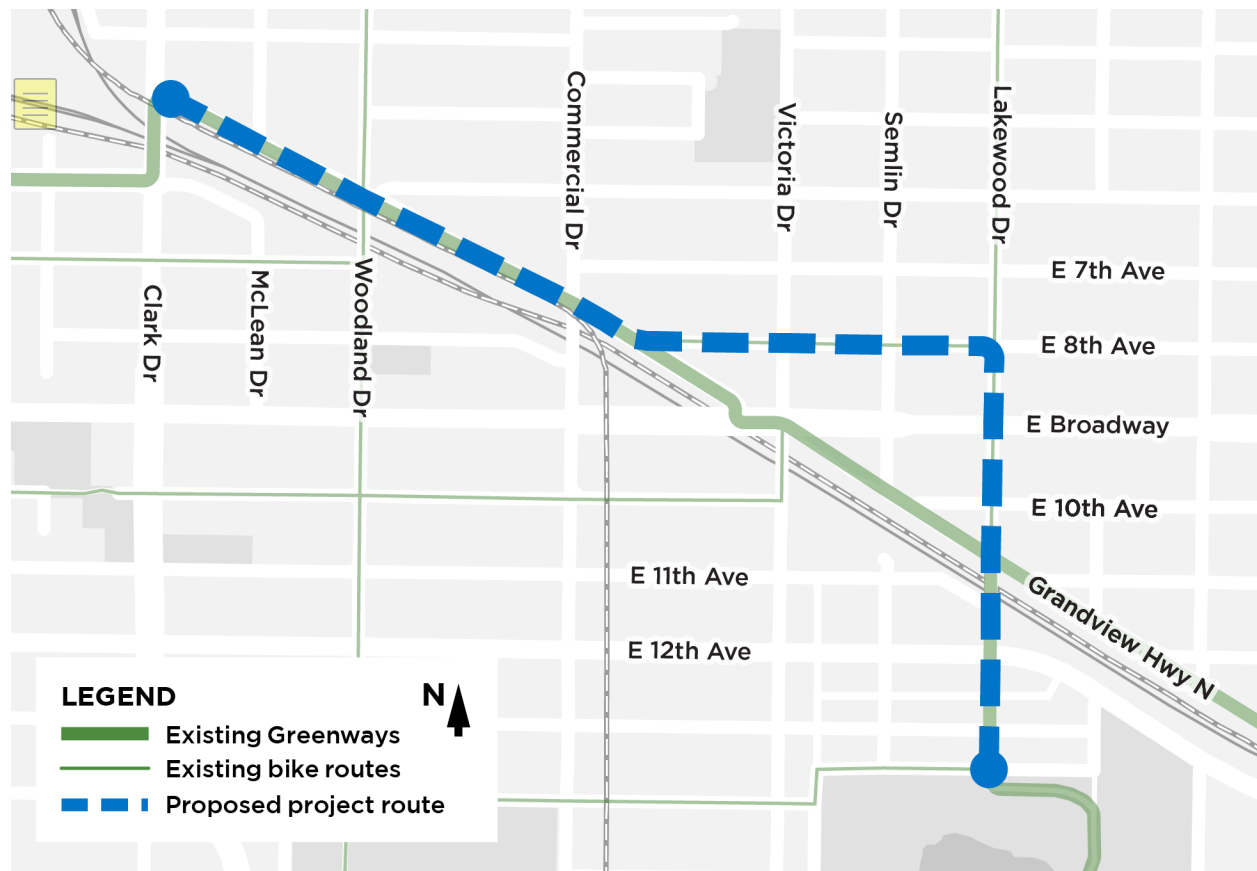
The Central Valley Greenway (CVG) between Clark Dr and John Hendry Park has been identified for improvements to provide a safer and more comfortable cycling connection between the area's local and regional destinations (e.g. Commercial Drive, John Hendry Park, and

Commercial Broadway SkyTrain Station). The proposed upgrades would impact the following streets:

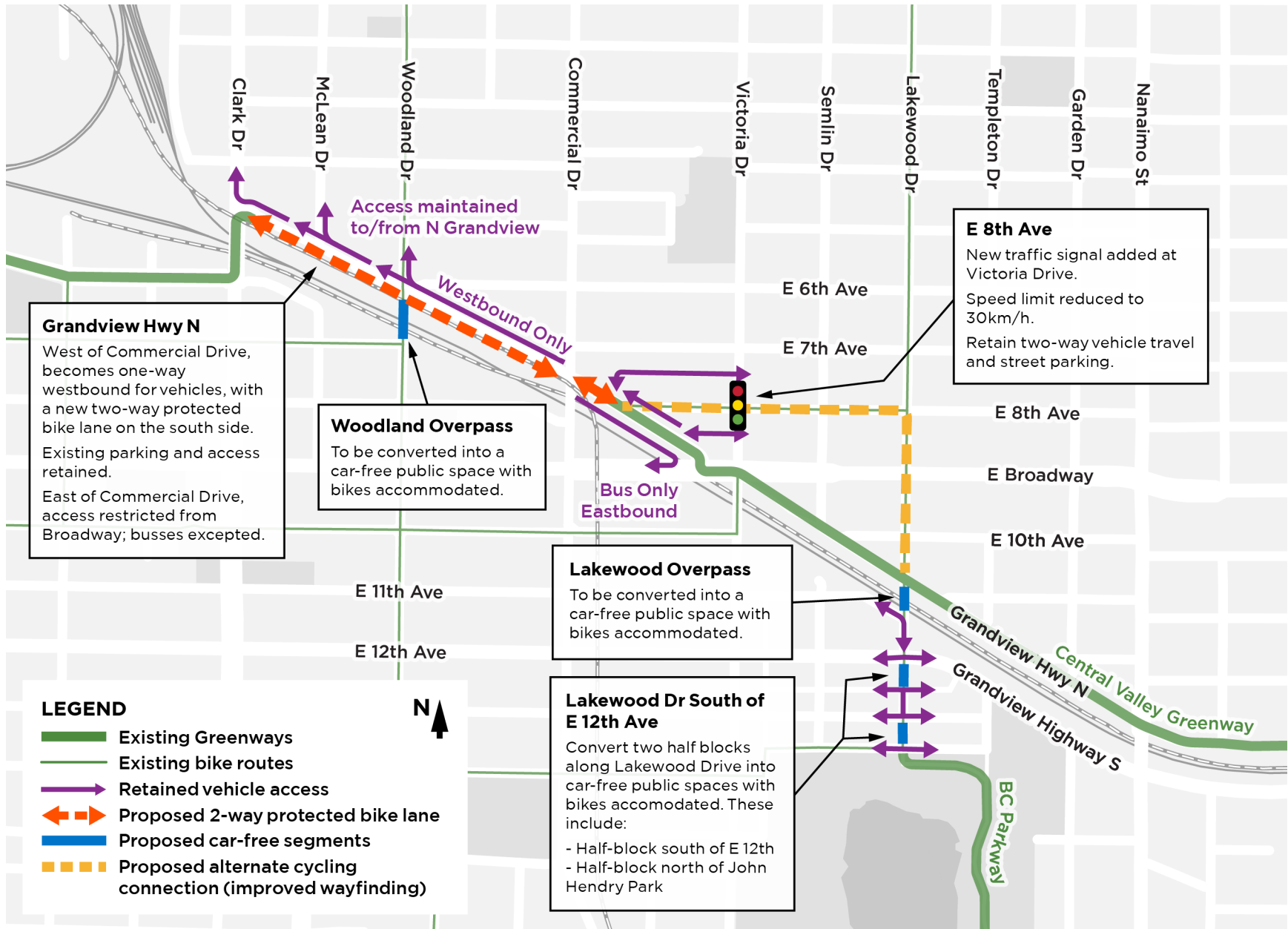
- Grandview Highway North (between Clark Drive and Lakewood Drive)
- Woodland overpass
- E 8th Ave (between Grandview Highway North and Lakewood Drive)
- Lakewood Drive (between E 8th Ave and John Hendry Park)

Proposed Upgrades - Central Valley Greenway

The project area and route is shown below.



A more detailed map, outlining the proposed changes is on the next page. Apart from the new traffic signal to be installed at Victoria Dr and E 8th Ave, the proposed upgrades detailed in the following page will be implemented primarily using interim materials, such as concrete gravity barriers, to enable us to make changes as needed to better serve the greenway connection and community.
