# Purpose, Intent and Eligibility

The purpose and intent of the <u>Community Housing Incentive Program</u> (CHIP) grant is to assist non-profit and co-op housing providers in constructing affordable housing on their own land in Vancouver. This program seeks to complement senior government funding programs so that the City's range of affordability objectives across unit types and rent mix may be met.

Through CHIP Stream 1, the City supports non-market housing projects that are self-sustaining and leverage capital funding and low-cost senior government financing.

Through CHIP Stream 2, the City supports non-market housing projects that target a deep level of affordability and rely on ongoing operating subsidies from senior governments (e.g. BC Housing's CHF and IHF).

The organization shall have an independent, active governing body composed of volunteers. Its main responsibilities shall be program and policy development and fundraising. The Board is held responsible for the effectiveness of services provided and the financial accountability for funds received from all sources. Voting members of the Board of Directors of a Society receiving funds from the City of Vancouver may not be remunerated for services to the society, but they may be reimbursed for expenses.
