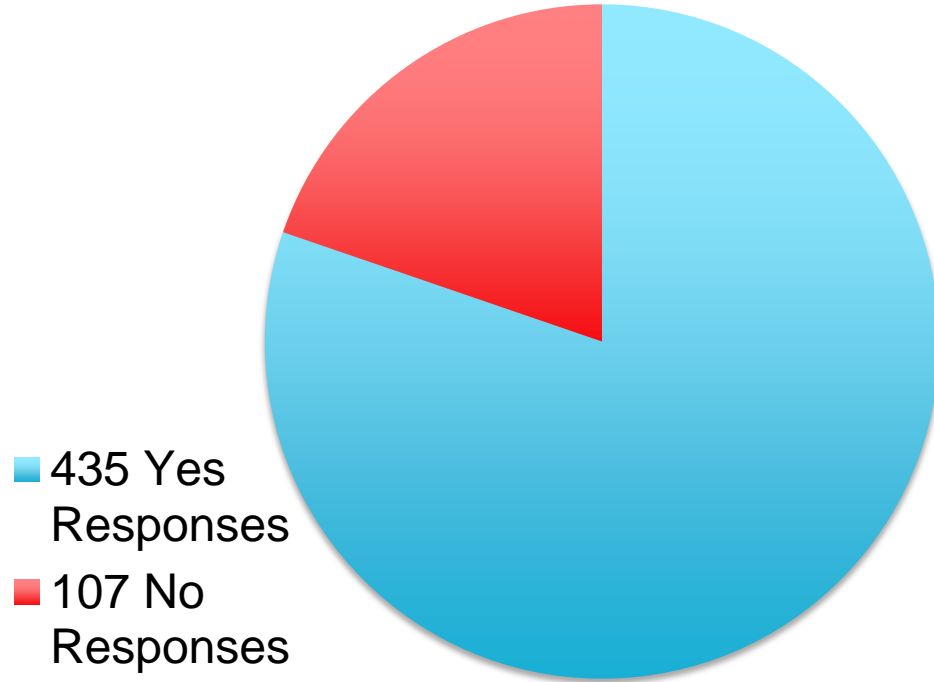
In 2018, the Youth Advocacy Committee (YAC) identifies lack of youth-only spaces in Vancouver

DO YOUTH NEED A YOUTH ONLY SPACE?

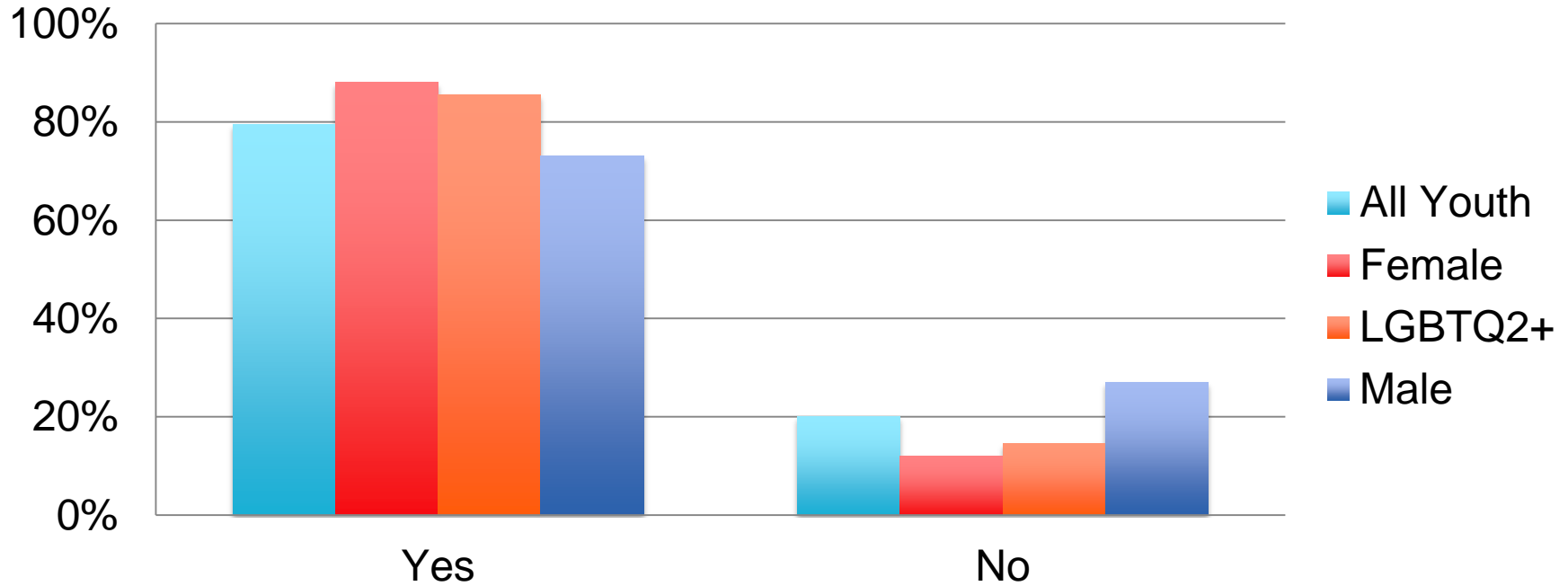

“Youth-only spaces allow youth to express themselves freely without worrying about being judged for topics of discussion or language.”

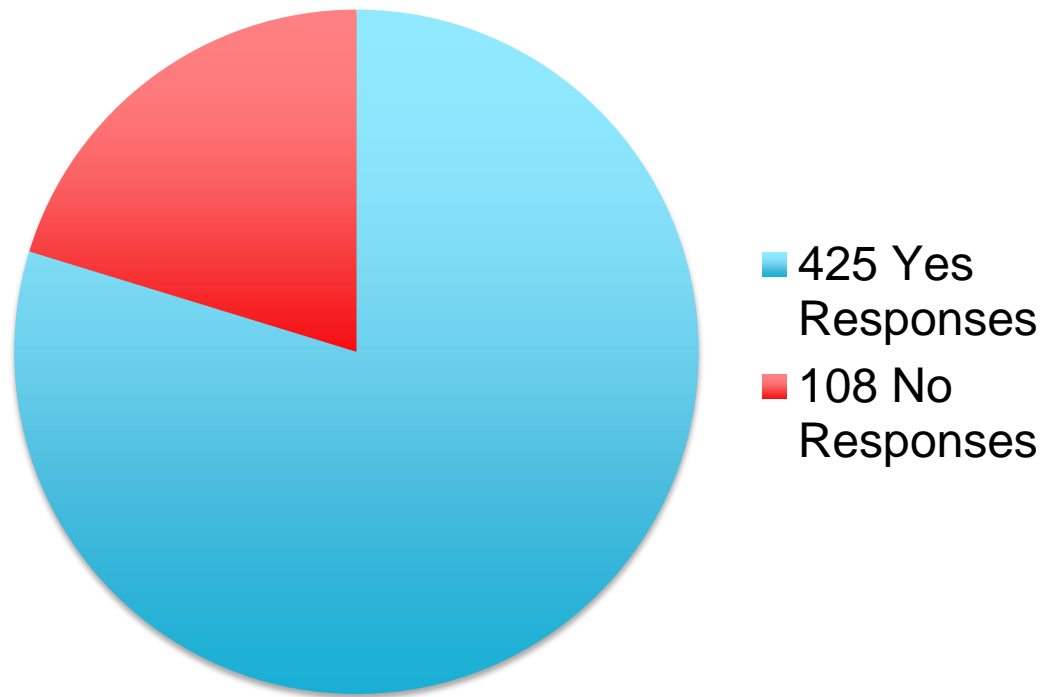

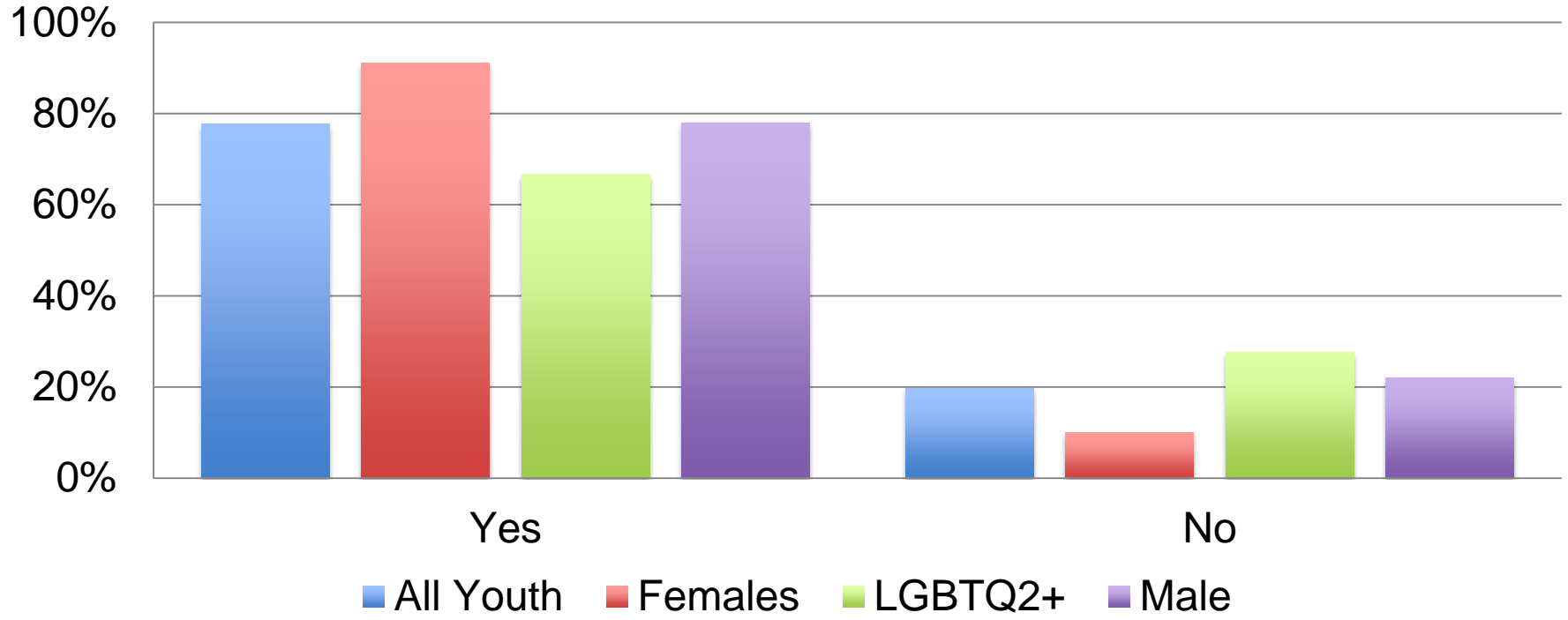


“Accessibility is important. Most youth don’t drive, so it should be close enough to walk to.”

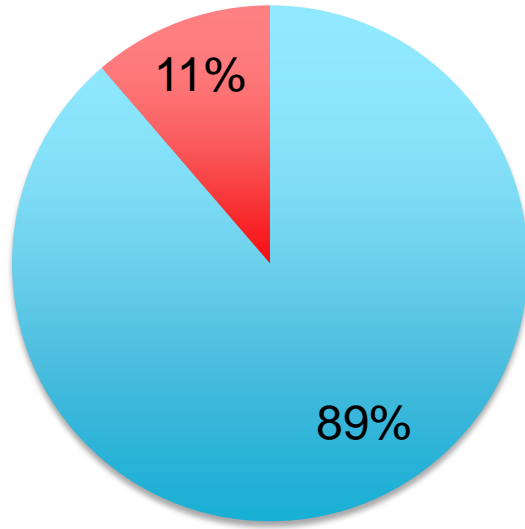
% 'Yes' vs 'No' Responses

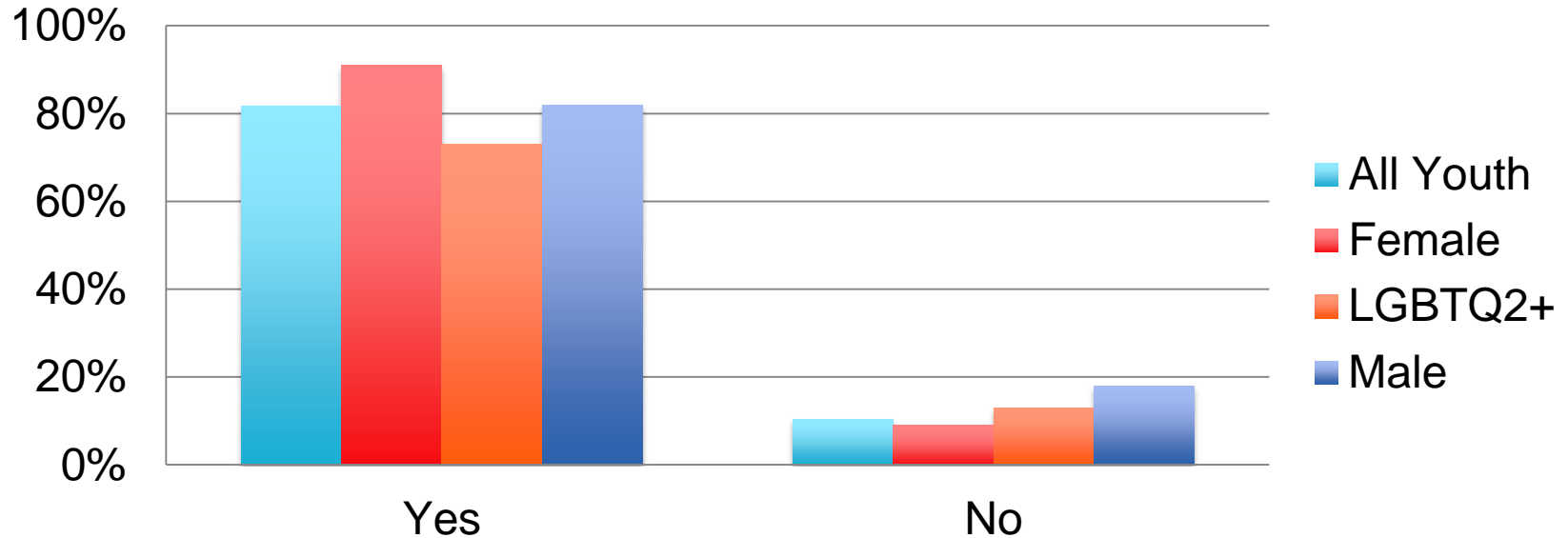

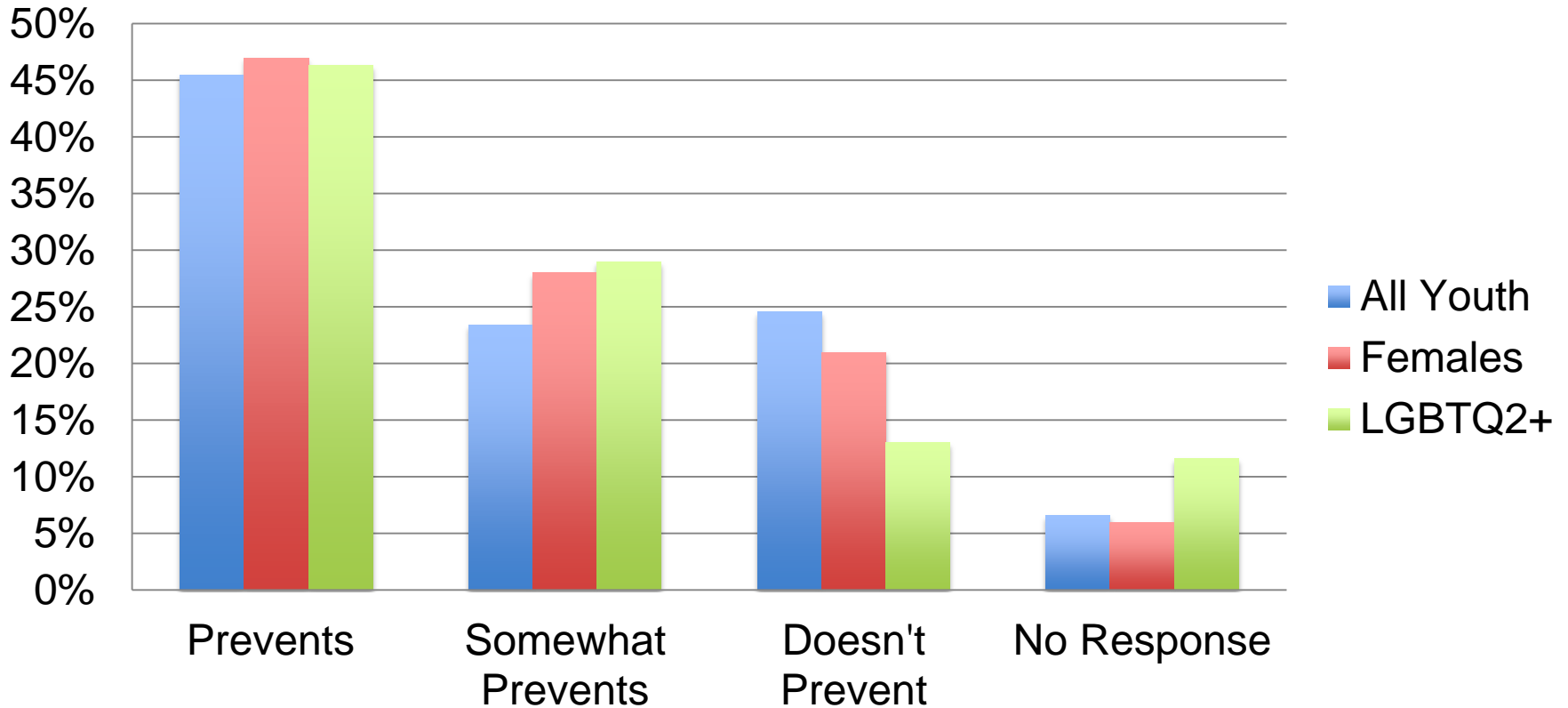

% of 'Yes' vs 'No' Responses

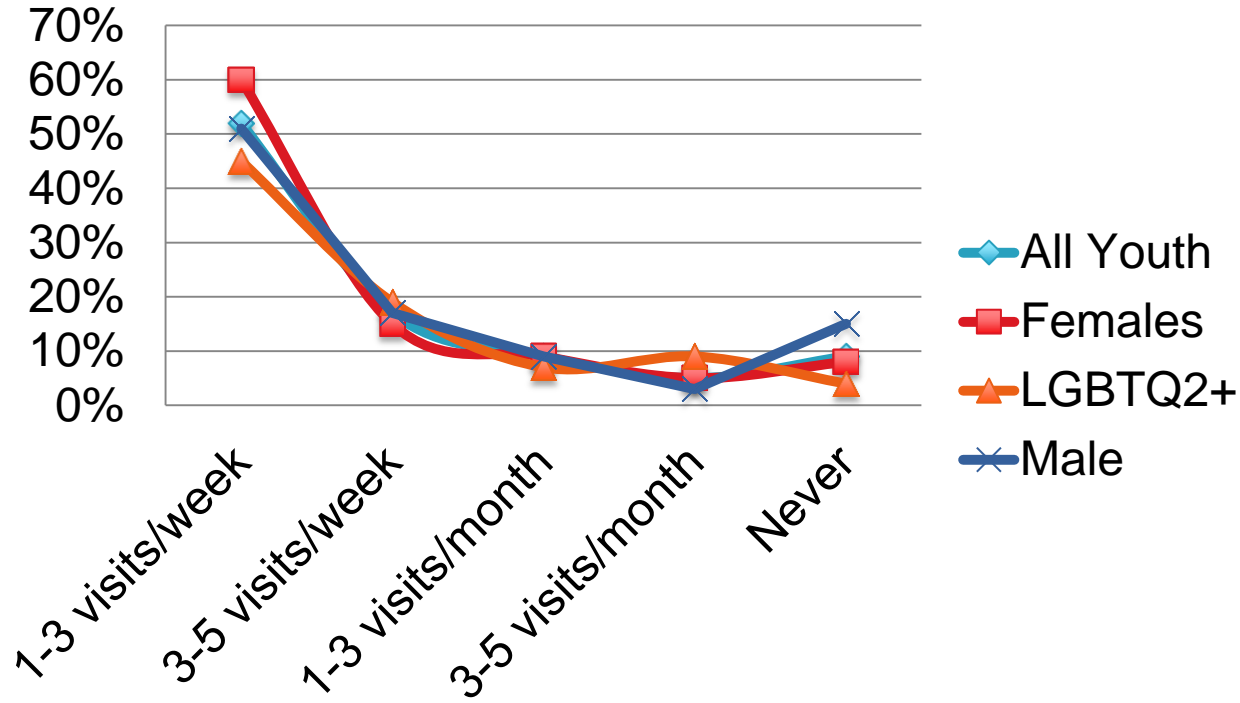


DOES COST AFFECT YOUR PARTICIPATION?



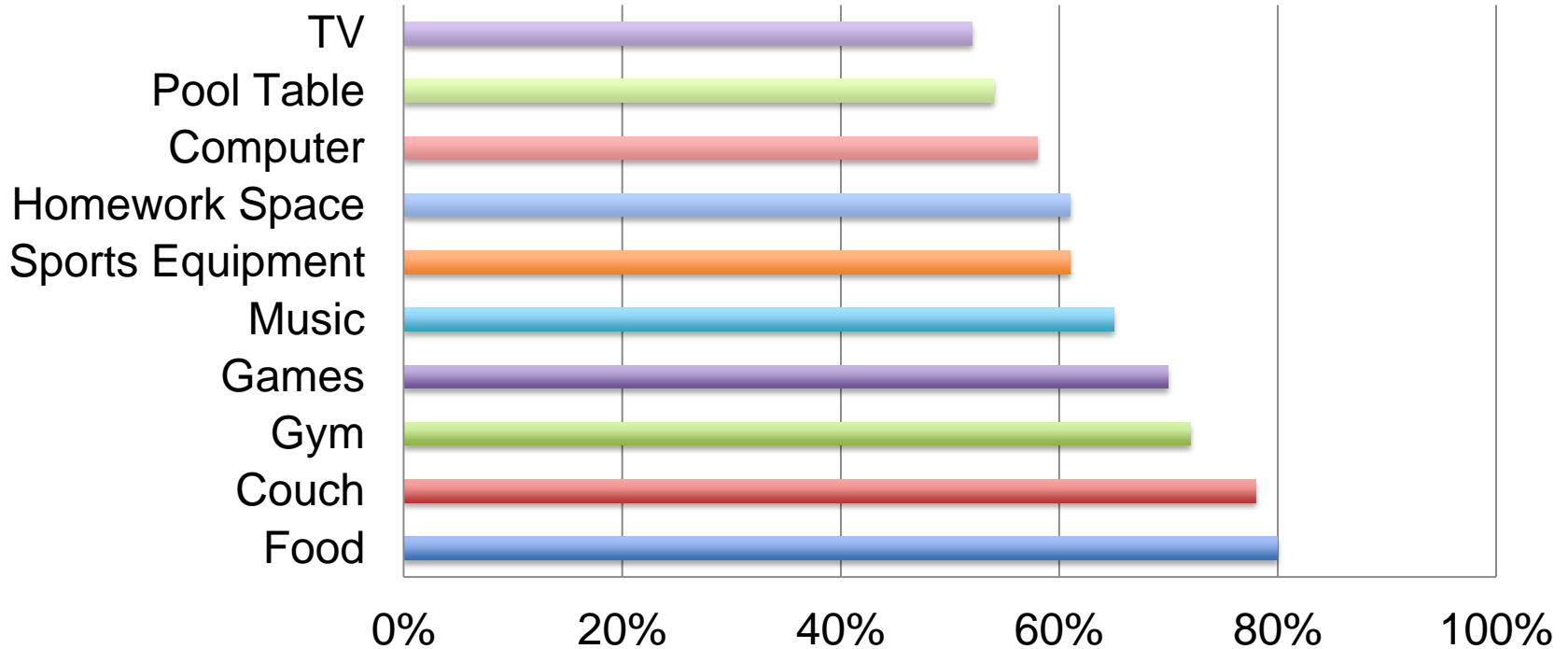
HOW OFTEN DO YOU COME TO THE CENTRE?
