The Climate Emergency Action Plan's **indicators framework** tracks how our actions will:

- cut Vancouver's **carbon pollution**
- benefit Vancouver's **economy**
- improve **equity**

The City will provide **annual progress reports**.

We will adjust course as necessary to stay on track for our targets, and we will update the framework as more accurate data becomes available.

## EQUITY IN THE FRAMEWORK

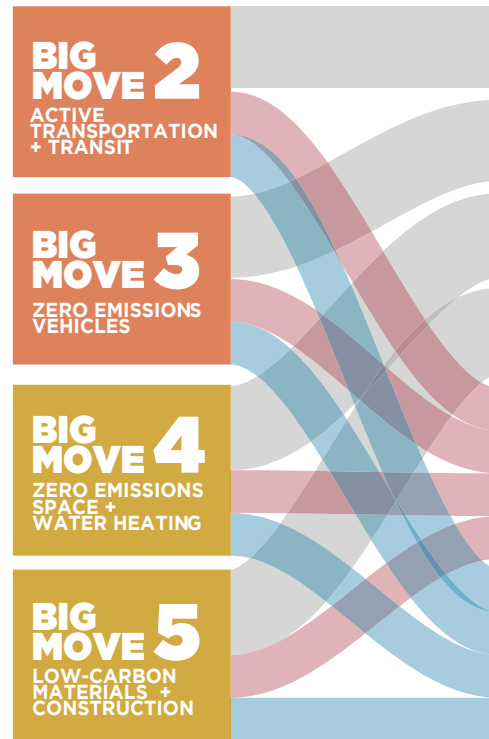
Equity within the CEAP is both a *process* and an *outcome*. Do our climate actions disproportionately impact anyone, and how can we address that?

The City will use data to plan our programs and to track the outcomes.

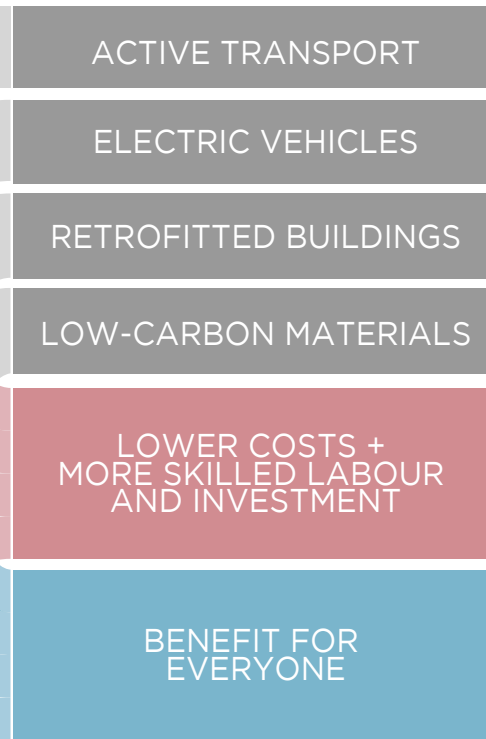
**Equity milestones** are a first step in our commitment to explore, develop and embed equity considerations into our actions.

**Equity indicators** will be developed during program design, guided by the City's forthcoming *Equity Framework* and *Climate Justice Charter*.

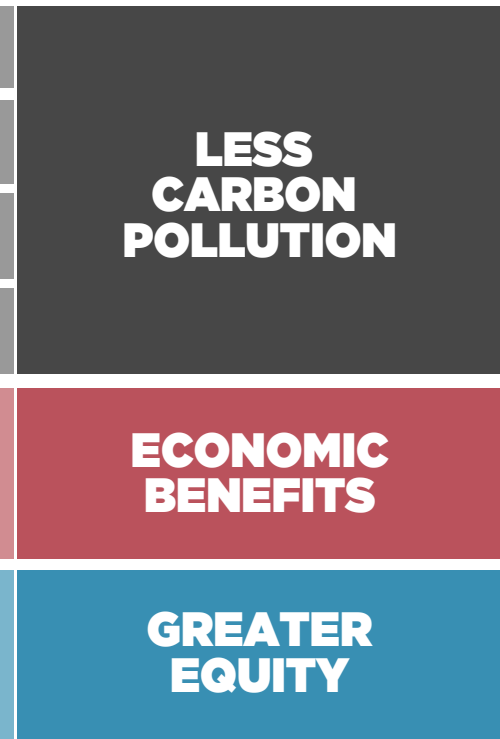
## MILESTONES MARK PROGRESS ON ACTIONS

## THREE LEVELS OF MEASUREMENT

Each level of the Indicators Framework contributes to the next. Here are some examples.

### Milestone

**Big Move 2** Install more sidewalk curb cuts and signaling

*Improving walking and cycling network will help increase usage.*

### Outcome

More residents choose to walk instead of drive

*Target: 2/3 trips by active modes/transit*

Underserved areas in Vancouver are improved first, and people of all abilities enjoy access

### Headline

Vancouver's carbon pollution goes down

*Target: -50% carbon pollution*

### Milestone

**Big Move 4** Support job-skills training for retrofits

*More homes can be easily and cost-effectively retrofitted to emit less carbon pollution if there is greater local industry expertise. Focus can be placed on groups underrepresented in the trades.*

### Outcome

Carbon pollution from buildings goes down

*Target: -50% carbon pollution*

More expertise to support growing market for low-carbon retrofits  
Greater opportunity for diverse and small contractors

### Headline

Vancouver's carbon pollution goes down

*Target: -50% carbon pollution*

Vancouver's number of green jobs goes up
