CP Program History

History

- Initiated by the City of Vancouver in 1978; City of Vancouver Council passed the CP Bylaw in 1982
- In 1991, Surrey City Council passed an amendment to the Surrey Building Bylaw to allow for an alternative plan and field review process using Certified Professionals
- In 2019, Tsleil-Waututh Nation (TWN) and the University Endowment Lands (UEL) adopted the CP program.
- In 2020, City of Abbotsford Council passed an amendment to the Abbotsford Building Bylaw to allow for an alternative plan and field review process using Certified Professionals.
