3. 320 E Hastings St - DP-2020-00721 – DEOD (COMPLETE APPLICATION)

Applicant: NSDA Architects

Request: To develop on this site an eleven (11) storey mixed-use building containing

Social Service Centre (main - third floor) and Social Housing (fourth–eleventh floor), containing a total of one hundred & five (105) dwelling units, all over one level of underground parking, providing a total of fifteen (15)

parking spaces having vehicular access from lane.

Development Planner's Opening Comments

Mr. Patrick Chan, Development Planner, presented the proposal and summarized the recommendations contained in the Staff Committee Report. The recommendation was for support of the application, subject to the conditions noted.

Mr. Patrick Chan took questions from the Board and Panel members.

Applicant's Comments

The applicant noted they are confident they can work with staff to meet the conditions for approval.

Applicant commented on the following conditions:

Regarding, condition 1.2 (iii.) Introduce weather protection on both Hastings Street and Gore Avenue. Applicant noted it was felt strongly by First United Church the weather protection will be challenging to provide safe operations of the building.

Regarding, condition 2.3 Loading Management plan. Applicant requesting these conditions be set aside.

Applicant noted the conditions are onerous to the project. There is no opportunity to provide the added loading bays of the project without taking away program space.

Regarding, condition 2.5 (i) provision of convenient, internal, stair-free loading access to/from all site uses; Applicant noted there are stairs leading up to the length from the main level of the building; a dock leveler has been added to overcome the distance in terms of the actual loading

bay; therefore this clause is somewhat misleading as the equivalency is provided with the dock leveler.

Regarding, condition 1.4 (ii) introduce juliette balconies to all studio and one-bedroom (both typical and adaptable) to improve access to light and air; Applicant noted it was discussed with city staff that the intent of the clause was to provide the maximize amount of light air ventilation and not the actual provision of a balcony.
