

Improving Transit on East Hastings Street

Longer bus lane hours and better bus stop spacing.



More than 1,000 buses connect riders across Vancouver, Burnaby and the North Shore via Hastings St every day.

BUS PRIORITY IMPROVEMENTS

The first phase of transit improvements on the Hastings corridor includes:

Spring 2026

Extending bus lanes to 24/7 in the following areas on Hastings St:

- Eastbound from Kaslo St to Boundary Rd
- Westbound from Boundary Rd to Renfrew St

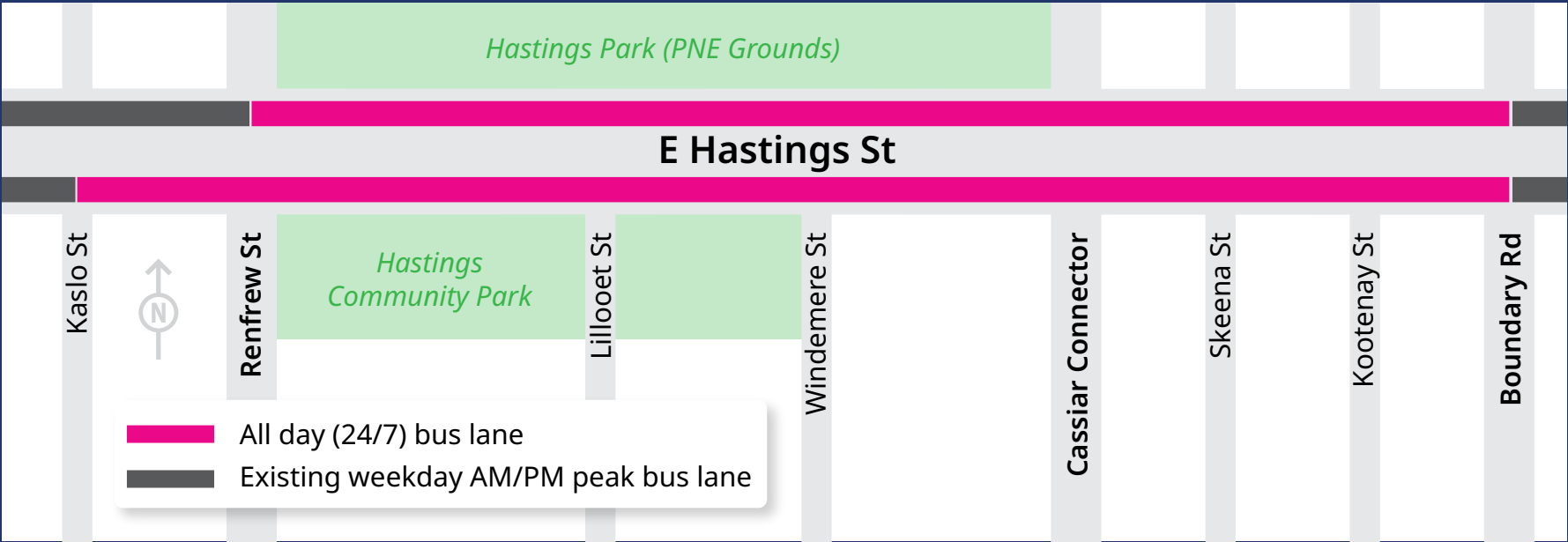
Fall 2026

Adjusting some bus stop locations between downtown and Boundary Rd.

These changes will:

- Help buses move smoothly and stay on time
- Make trips quicker and more reliable on routes 3, 8, 14, 16, 20, 27, 28, 130, 131, 160, 222, R5, N35, and the upcoming R2 extension
- Improve transit access to key destinations

Parking and loading hours may be changed on side streets to reduce project impacts.
