



What We Heard - History & Context Workshop

- Desire to acknowledge and strengthen understanding of Indigenous history
- Don't lose sight of the area's industrial heritage
- Natural setting is an important characteristic water as a central feature
- FCS is unique due to the planning legacy
- Neighbourhood character: village-like urban design

What We Heard - History & Context Workshop

- Community mix is integral to FCS's identity
- Strong sense of community should be retained
- Desire to be able to continue living in the community, while welcoming new residents
- Co-ops are a fundamental feature
- Amenities need to reflect population demographic
