**RE: Kingsway-Main St Transit Improvements**

Dear business owner,

Parking changes are coming to Kingsway and Main St to improve transit service, in partnership with TransLink. This letter focuses on Kingsway between Main Street and Dumfries Street.

Starting in April, existing parking restrictions will be extended to slightly longer hours on both sides of Kingsway between Main Street and Dumfries Street, and the curb lane will become a bus lane at the following times (see map on p. 4):

- North/westbound - Weekday AM peak hours: 7-10am, Monday to Friday
- South/eastbound - Weekday PM peak hours: 3-7pm, Monday to Friday

At some intersections, minor changes to improve traffic flow will be installed (see map on p. 4):

- Extended 'no stopping zones' for vehicles to make right-turns more easily
- New or extended left-turn restrictions

These changes will help buses move smoothly through traffic and support faster and more reliable bus service for thousands of transit riders.

## **What we heard**

In October 2025, the City asked businesses and the public for feedback on the proposed bus lanes changes. Based on feedback received, we are making the following changes on Kingsway between Main Street and Dumfries Street:

- Reinstating weekday midday street parking at four spaces on Kingsway near Broadway
- Allowing loading to take place in the morning on Kingsway near E 15th Avenue
- Adding loading zones on E 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, E 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue and E 16th Avenue
- Relocating a loading zone from the south side of E 6th Avenue to the north side
- Adding some street parking on the north side of E 7th Avenue
- Adding time limits and pay parking to some unregulated parking spaces on E 7th Avenue, E 8th Avenue, Carolina Street, E 16th Avenue, and Knight St
- Removing rush regulations to allow parking at ten spaces on Knight Street near 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue

## **What to expect during installation**

Installation is expected to begin in April and finish in June. Curbside and traffic signs, and new pavement markings will be installed:

- Overhead bus lane signs along Kingsway
- Parking signs updated to reflect new parking regulations on Main Street and some side streets
- Refreshed bus lane paint and markings

Always check signs before parking or loading on the street. Temporary parking restrictions will be in place. Watch for “No Parking” signs as work progresses.

Planned work hours:

- Monday to Friday: 7am–5 pm
- Saturday (if required): 7am–5 pm
- Sunday (if required): 10am–5 pm

Some overnight work or off-work hours may be required. All work will comply with construction noise requirements.

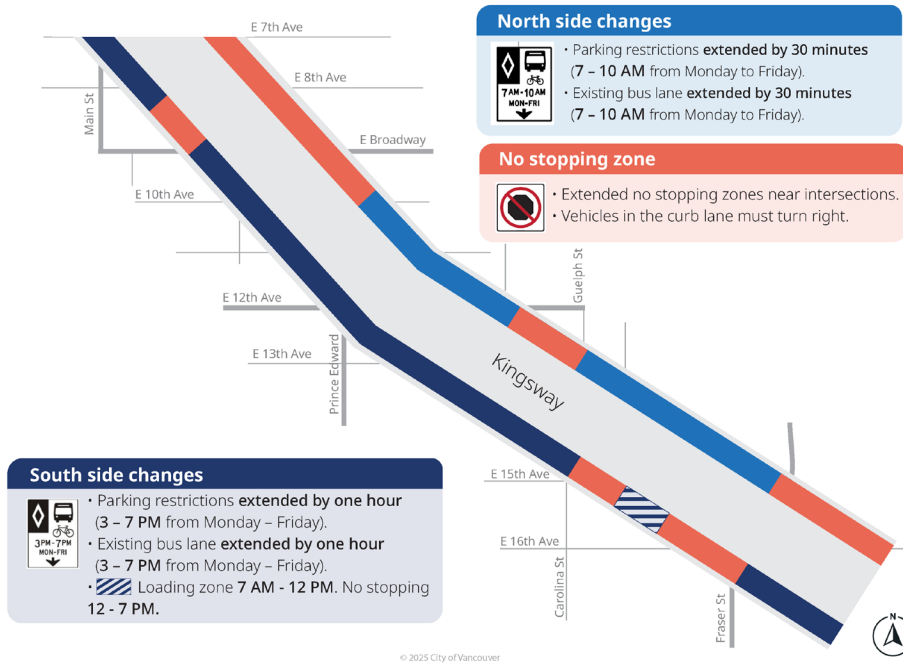
