#### Step 1

Select one of the fact sheets that excites you. Using the Jigsaw worksheet, visually represent this fact sheet in one of the blank jigsaw pieces.



#### Step 2

Visit <http://shapeyourcity.ca>. Select one of the ‘In Progress’ projects that relates to your fact sheet. Using the Jigsaw worksheet, visually represent this project in one of the blank jigsaw pieces.



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### ➔ Step 3

Maneuver through your chosen project on the Shape Your City website. Is there anything missing, or exciting, that catches your eye? Draw this in one of the empty jigsaw pieces.

### ➔ Step 4

What could the future of this project look like? Draw this in the final empty piece of the jigsaw puzzle.

### ➔ Step 5

Share your completed puzzle in pairs or in small groups. Discuss how your chosen factsheet led you to decide on your Shape Your City project, and how each piece of your jigsaw puzzle relates to one another. You may also use this time to submit your thoughts on the Shape Your City website.
