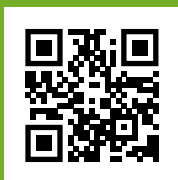


# MECHANICAL PERMIT



As of July 1, 2022, a mechanical permit is required for all heating and cooling installations in Vancouver

Beginning July 1, 2022 a mechanical permit is required before a heating or cooling system is installed in any type of building.

The majority of permits will be issued electronically upon completion of the application. Incomplete applications may result in delays. Apply online at **[vancouver.ca/mechanical-permit](https://vancouver.ca/mechanical-permit)**

### 1-3 Storey Residential Update

- As of January 1, 2022 nearly all new 1-3 storey residential buildings are required to use electric source options, such as heat pumps or electric boilers, for space heating and domestic hot water systems.

### Municipal Heat Pump Certification (MHPC)

- Municipal Heat Pump Certification is required for all new residential heat pump applications beginning July 1, 2022.
