**RE: Nanaimo Street Upgrades - Upcoming Construction from McGill St to 4<sup>th</sup> Ave**

On February 4, 2019, the City will begin construction as part of the Nanaimo Street Upgrades between McGill Street and E 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Work will begin at Nanaimo and Eton Street by upgrading critical sewer infrastructure and the project will continue until spring 2020.

- **What:** sewer separation coordinated with potential street improvements
- **When:** February 4, 2019 - spring 2020

**Street Improvements: Thank You for Your Feedback**

Thank you to everyone who took the time to connect with us to provide feedback about the proposed street safety improvements. Staff are currently reviewing the feedback in more detail, and a summary along with next steps will be available in the coming weeks at [vancouver.ca/nanaimoupgrades](http://vancouver.ca/nanaimoupgrades).

**What to Expect During Construction**

*Construction Staging:* Work will begin at Nanaimo and Eton Street, and progress south. Construction will typically be underway along three-block segments, with work sometimes active along more than one segment at a time.

*Property Access:* Access to residences and businesses will be maintained at all times. If you're a business owner and missed the printed version of our construction guide *Road Work on Your Street: Ideas for Businesses*, a digital copy is available at [vancouver.ca/roadwork](http://vancouver.ca/roadwork). To request a printed copy, please connect with our team at [nanaimoupgrades@vancouver.ca](mailto:nanaimoupgrades@vancouver.ca).

*Work Hours:* Construction will generally take place, Monday to Friday from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm, with extended hours (up to 8:00 pm on weekdays) and weekends as needed.

*Parking & Traffic Impacts:* At least one lane of traffic in each direction will generally be maintained during active construction hours, and traffic control personnel will be on-site to help guide all road users. Parking restrictions will be in effect to accommodate construction and will be lifted as soon as they're no longer needed. Please be sure to watch for *No Parking* signs as work progresses.

*Noise & Vibration:* Efforts will be made to minimize noise, particularly during early hours, however, some noise and dust is expected during construction. Trucks and heavy machinery are required and will be sharing access roads.

*Removal of Trees:* The sidewalk repairs and sewer separation require the removal of approximately 20 trees. New trees will be planted in the neighboring vicinity to off-set those removed as per the City's Greenest City Action Plan and Urban Forest Strategy.

*Water Supply:* We will provide advance notice of any disruption to your water supply, except if there is an emergency. During construction, you may occasionally notice cloudy water. This cloudiness is not a health concern and will usually resolve within a few hours.

We apologize for any inconvenience and thank you in advance for your understanding and patience as we undertake these infrastructure upgrades. During construction, please feel free to discuss any immediate concerns you may have with the crew on site, as they will be happy to assist you.




Figure 1: Sewer Separation & Proposed Street Improvements
