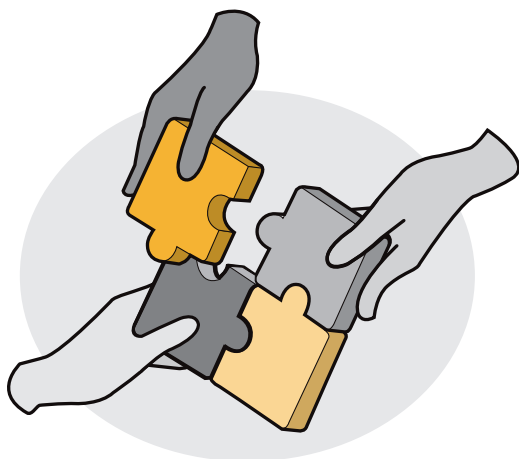

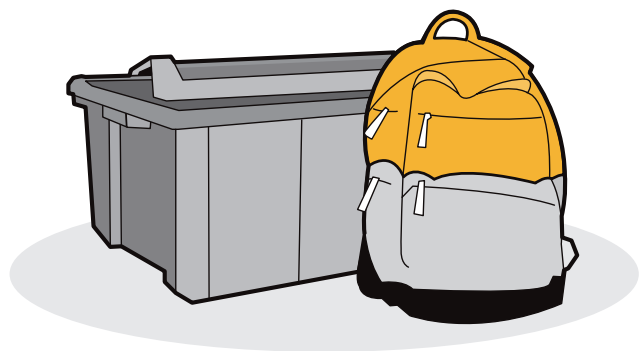
# BINGO!



**In a major emergency, your neighbours are often your first responders.**

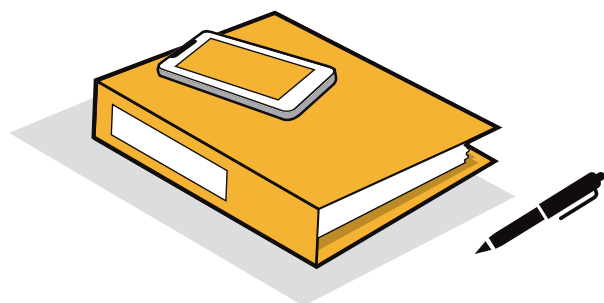
More connected communities are more resilient and recover more quickly from emergencies.

**It's not just about what is in your kit, but also who is in your kit!**

Some of these may be obvious, like having an emergency kit or knowing how to use a fire extinguisher. Others may not be as obvious but are just as important. Someone who has lived in the neighbourhood longer or knows several neighbours may be more connected and know the resources and vulnerabilities of the neighbourhood.
