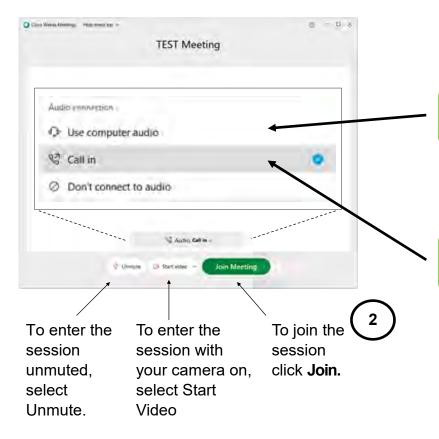
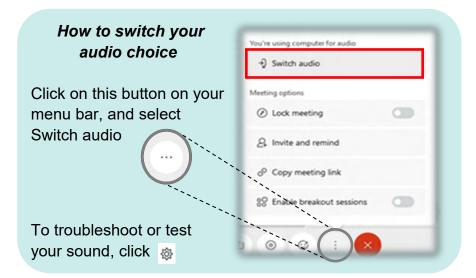
# Quick Reference Guide | Using Webex Events

# Join a session

To begin, click on the Webex session link that was provided. For community centre registrants, this may be in your receipt notes. You can join using a desktop computer, phone, or tablet. We recommend joining from a computer for best performance.

You will need to read and agree to the privacy notice in order to join the session. When you agree, the Webex window will launch. *More info on page 2.* 





## **Browser Compatibility**

Webex is compatible with Chrome, Chromium, Edge, Firefox, Internet Explorer, & Safari.



Select which audio type you will use for the session:

# Join using computer audio

Select *Use computer audio* from the menu.

# Join using phone audio

Select Call in from the menu.

Call-in numbers will automatically appear:

- Call the local phone number listed
- If an access code or attendee ID is provided, enter these when prompted.

# More information & features

#### **Audio Issues**

Are you having troubles with your audio? Try these tips.

## I can't hear anything.

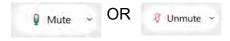
 Check the speaker sound on your computer.
Look for these common symbols located either on your screen or your keyboard.



 If you have a speaker system or headphones with On/Off settings, check that they are ON.

#### No one can hear me.

 Check to make sure your meeting microphone is on. At the bottom of your meeting window is the mute button. When you click it, you will toggle between unmuted (green) or muted (red).

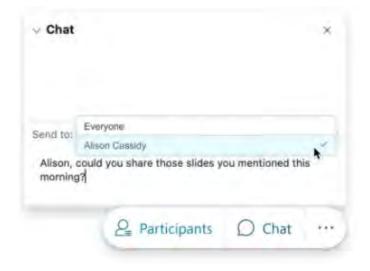


- If using headphones, check if the mute button is activated on the headphones.
- Check your microphone settings on your computer or headphones. Turn these ON.
- For phone audio, unmute yourself using \*6.
- You may be muted by the host.

## **Chat panel or Q&A panel**

You can send messages and questions to the host and other people in the session. Click Chat to open the chat panel. By default, your chat messages go to everyone in the meeting.

To send a question that is only seen by the host, use the Q&A panel and select "Send privately". You can allow others to see your question by selecting "Send publicly".



#### **Exit Webex**

To leave the session, click the red X button
